Services are available within 72 hours (3 days) across Maryland and across the lifespan – any age, any disability. Offer quality care if your favorite respite provider is not available. Pre-registration options available, including resource identification. Approval for emergency respite will be determined within 48 hours of request. A family may only make one request per 12-month period and the maximum grant per family is \$225 per 12-month period. Funded by the Maryland Department of Human Services.
