Voluntary program that offers offenders with drug/alcohol-dependency problems a new opportunity to break the chain of the cycle of drug/alcohol addiction and crime through intensive treatment and monitoring, as well as direct attention from the court. The mission of the Adult Drug Court Program is to eliminate substance abuse, crime, and their consequence, by forging continuing partnerships with the court, health treatment providers, concerned community organizations and law enforcement. Leveraging its partnerships and authority, the court will direct substance-abusing offenders into evaluation and treatment to achieve personal responsibility and productive citizenship. The program consists of three phases and the minimum length of treatment is 20 months, but the actual length of stay is dependent on a participant's progress.

Provide a comprehensive array of recovery and support services to Montgomery County youth ages 12 to 17 through programs designed to support youth through their recovery process and engage them in their own recovery. This is accomplished through activities that promote development in the areas of: Education, Vocation and Career, Recovery from Substance Abuse, Social/Recreational, and Healthy Living. Program Areas: Relapse Prevention & Recovery Planning; Job Readiness; Peer Support Groups; Youth Leadership Opportunities; Art, Cooking and Computer Skills Development; Homework Supervision, Assistance and Study Skills Development; and Recreational Games – Video/Wii Tournament. Participants are referred to The Landing through SASCA, Juvenile Drug Court, DJS Intake and Probation, Montgomery County Public Schools, local non-profits, and substance abuse and treatment programs. Walk-ins are always welcome and eligibility for membership will be determined upon individual referrals.

Inpatient Medical Detoxification: Patients requesting detoxification services are evaluated in our Emergency department. Patients meeting medical criteria are admitted to our inpatient unit for the safe management of their withdrawal from alcohol and other substances.

Addiction Partial Hospitalization Program: Step-down program for those who have completed the Inpatient Medical Detoxification service. Provides group-oriented, structured day program seven days a week.

Outpatient Addiction Treatment Service: Intensive outpatient program offers treatment to those suffering from addictions. Patients remain in their communities and are able to work and continue their usual activities. Meets three evenings a week.

Relapse Prevention Program: A step-down service that patients may attend after completing an intensive outpatient addiction program, such as OATS. The program provides additional support and education to help patients maintain abstinence. Meets two evenings a week.

Outpatient Addiction and Mental Health Services delivers care to individuals with mental health and substance abuse symptoms and disability. This program was formerly operated by the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services. Symptoms are serious enough that extensive support, monitoring and accommodation is necessary for the individual to participate in the treatment process; but there is no evidence of significant danger to self or others, a need for detoxification, or 24-hour psychiatric supervision. These individuals may have a history of suicide. Disability is defined as long-term, potentially lifelong, functional impairment as a result of substance dependence and/or a mental health disorder. This includes persons with severe and persistent mental illnesses who have a significant history of relapse, multiple recurrences of a mental health disorder, and/or evidence of continued impairment in several areas (capacity to manage relationships, job, finances and social interactions). Referrals are now made by the Access Team to contract providers in Montgomery County.

Provides in-person or telephone clinical assessment and financial screening and referral for public services; consultation to assist agencies/programs in planning for clients with mental health and/or substance abuse needs; and information about mental health services in Montgomery County.
