As Veterans Day approaches on Tuesday, November 11, Montgomery County is preparing to join the national "Operation Green Light" salute to veterans. Montgomery County Executive Marc Elrich and the County Council are supporting the effort to join Operation Green Light, a program sponsored by the National Association of Counties to honor those who have made immeasurable sacrifices to preserve freedom. asks for displays of a green light, from November 4 through November 11, in a window of businesses or residences to honor veterans. From November 4 through November 11, Montgomery County's Memorial Plaza, which is located adjacent to the County Executive Building at 101 Monroe Street in Rockville, will be lit with green lights. Keynote Speaker: Vietnam War Veteran Takeshi "Tak" Furumoto. Takeshi Furumoto was born in the Tule Lake Segregation Center. After being released from the incarceration camp in December 1945, his family moved temporarily to Hiroshima, Japan, four months after the atomic bombing. Living in Nishihara, a suburb of Hiroshima City that was only seven miles from the epicenter of the atomic bomb, his extended family and many of his classmates were hibakusha, or victims of the atomic bomb.
