Children's Services: Provide fully-inclusive child care for children ages six weeks to 10 years with and without developmental disabilities and chronic medical conditions. Provide case management services for children from birth to age three who have a diagnosed condition, a developmental delay, or atypical development. Service Coordinators arrange family training, counseling, home visits, developmental education services, therapy services, and more. Low Intensity Support Services are designed to help families provide for the needs of a child with a developmental disability living in the community as well as an adult with developmental disabilities living in their home. Support youth up to age 21 through social and recreational opportunities and provide retail skills training to interested young adults. Autism Waiver program provides information and support for children diagnosed on the Autism spectrum. Offer workshops on a variety of special education topics. Youth employment programs consists of six months of classroom training, placement, job coaching and drop-in support once the student secures employment. **Adult Services:** Supports adults with disabilities by providing job skills training, employment, community volunteer and recreational opportunities, community living services (housing), and advocacy. **Adults 60+:** Respite program can provide short-term relief for a few hours, a day, a weekend, or sometimes longer. Respite is funded primarily through a contract with the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services. **Employment Programs:** Individualized wrap-around services that enable individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to get and retain jobs. Services include training, placement and support for employment in inclusive, community-based settings.
