General Dentistry Adults: Patients are assigned to a student dentist who arranges appointments, provides general dentistry services, and arranges for specialty consultations and treatment. Services for adults include fillings, crowns, bridges, implant restorations, dentures, endodontics (root canals), esthetic dentistry (basic teeth whitening, bonding services, and tooth-colored fillings), periodontics (treatment of gum disease) and oral pathology consultations. Appointments are available Monday, Wednesday and Friday in the morning and afternoon. There is a \$150 non-refundable deposit to become a new patient at the school. This fee will be applied to any dental care that you have. The patient admissions appointment will include a detailed medical and dental history, basic exam, and any necessary diagnostic x-rays.

Pediatric Dentistry: Comprehensive oral health care services are available for children from infancy through age 18 in their Pediatric Dentistry Clinic in an environment designed especially for children. Services include comprehensive oral evaluation; assessment of risk of tooth decay; teeth cleaning; fluoride treatments; sealants; tooth-colored fillings; space maintainers (to save space for adult teeth); athletic mouth guards; teeth whitening (for adolescents); cosmetic dentistry; and emergency dental care.

Advanced General Dentistry: Post-doctoral clinic that offers comprehensive dental care, including routine cleanings and exams, fillings, crowns, bridges, implant restorations, dentures, and treatment of more complex general dentistry cases. In this clinic, dentists who have completed dental school and are receiving 1-2 additional years of training in advanced general dentistry provide treatment under the supervision of faculty dentists. Fees at the Advanced General Dentistry Clinic are slightly higher than at the Pre-Doctoral Clinics, though they are still lower than the fees charged by dentists in private practice.

Special Care and Geriatrics Services:

Comprehensive, special care is available for persons with disabilities, persons with complex medical problems, and older adults.

Emergency hours daily. Provide preventive, diagnostic, emergency and restorative oral health care to adults and children who are low-income and uninsured. A moderate fee is requested. Services include: Preventive (exams, cleanings, fluoride treatments, deep cleaning and digital x-rays); restorative (resin fillings); pediatric dentistry (exams, cleanings, fluoride treatments, sealants, fillings, stainsteel crowns, pulpotomies and extractions); endodontic (root canal therapy); crowns and bridge (zirconium, porcelain crown, and xed porcelain bridge); prosthodontics (complete, partial, immediate denture and denture relines); oral surgery (dental implants and extractions); emergency (emergency exams, dental treatment, and prescriptions).

Free services for WIC participants. Must be referred from WIC program or a medical services provider. Provide dental services for children six months of age and older, all special needs patients regardless of age, and adults. Provide preventative and restorative services including routine exams, teeth cleanings, x-rays, composite fillings, sealants, fluoride varnishes, simple extractions, and prophylaxis with fluoride. Providers demonstrate proper brushing and flossing techniques and offer patients take home dental supplies. Some emergency procedures are done at the clinic. Other emergencies will be referred.

Adult Dental Care: The Dental Services program provides dental care to eligible adults 19 to 59 years of age. The Dental Program is located at: 1401 Rocville Pike, Suite 300 North, Rockville, MD. 20852. Contact the office at: 240-777-1875 to schedule an appointment. Office hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. There are no walk ins please. To apply to the program and determine eligibility, contact the Adult Dental Eligibility Unit to get certified at: 240-777-1659. Persons 60 or over need to make an application with the Health Care Eligibility Unit. Senior Dental Program: The Dental Services program provides dental care to seniors 60 years and older. The program does not provide dentures. If eligibility has already been determined, contact one of the following numbers: for the Rockville location 240-777-1875, for the Silver Spring location 240-777-3135, for the Colesville location 240-777-4471, for the Germantown location 240-777-3291, 240-773-0304 for the Gaithersburg clinic to schedule an appointment (please, no walk ins). Hours: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Clinic offers an extensive range of dental treatments and oral healthcare services for adults and children. Dental treatment in the pre-doctoral clinic is rendered by their dental and dental hygiene students under the supervision of the faculty. The first appointment will be for evaluation to determine the patient's dental needs. Preliminary diagnostic radiographs are taken, and your record is forwarded to the patient pool for assignment to a student. Assignment is determined by your dental needs and how those needs will assist the student in obtaining his/her clinical experiences. Special services are offered to children in the Pediatric Dentistry and Orthodontic Clinics. Fees may be paid in the form of cash, check or credit card. Payment is due on the date service is provided. Patients with insurance must also pay at the time service is rendered. The College of Dentistry will complete an insurance claim for submission to your insurance carrier for reimbursement.

Diagnosis and treat disorders, conditions and injuries of the mouth, jaws, neck, face and skull including: jaw fracture; cheek bone fracture; nasal fracture; LeFort fracture; cutaneous malignancy (skin cancer); lip reconstruction; temporomandibular joint disorder; and incorrect bite. Also offer services for impacted teeth; difficult tooth extractions; extractions on medically compromised patients and bone grafting or pre-prosthetic surgery to provide better anatomy for the placement of implants, dentures, or other dental prosthesis. Accept most managed care and commercial health insurance.
