Coordinate with local churches and other community groups to provide lunch six days a week, dinner every Sunday, clothing with donated apparel, medical care and assistance with prescriptions, and showers plus toiletries, clean socks and underwear. Every two weeks, the weekday lunch program shifts location between two churches. Saturday lunch and Sunday dinner programs are always in the same locations. All are within an easy walk of their main office. Lunch is served Monday through Friday from 12:45 p.m. to 1:45 p.m. Every Saturday, lunch is served from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at Bethesda Presbyterian, 7601 Clarendon Road, Bethesda. Every Sunday, dinner is served from 5:00 p.m. to 5:50 p.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church, 7500 Pearl Street, Bethesda.

Food distribution program. Food boxes are shared at our warehouse daily and through a network of satellite locations. Many of these satellite locations serve seniors living in subsidized housing. If you need food, you will speak with one of our referral representatives, who will ask you some simple questions: 1. whether you are a Montgomery County resident; 2. whether your income falls below what is necessary to be self-sufficient; and 3. which day and location is most convenient for you to pick up your food. Please call Manna's main office during regular business hours. They need to receive your call by 3:00 pm the day before you would like to receive food, so they can have your order ready. When you come to pick up food, you need a photo ID with your current Montgomery County address, or provide a document that proves you currently reside in the county. If you cannot pick up your food on the day scheduled, you must call Manna in order to reschedule your pick up. If

you need to schedule a pick up outside of Manna's normal business hours, DIAL 311 to contact the Department of Health and Human Services. You can also get a referral from hundreds of referral agencies that work with Manna. Ask your case manager, social worker or pastor.

Men may shower from 7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and women may shower from 10:00 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Clothing is available on Tuesdays and Fridays from 8:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. ID is required. Other services include affordable housing, job training, addiction treatment, and counseling for the poor, the elderly, and individuals with mental illness.
