4. Purpose the Review Board: §14-404 At least every 6 months the review board shall conduct a record review of each guardianship that a public agency holds. The review board shall recommend that the guardianship be: continued, modified, or terminated. The disabled individual shall attend if able, be represented by the attorney that the disabled individuals chooses or an attorney who is appointed by the court. Except for purposes a judicial proceeding under this title, all records of the review board are confidential.
5. Open Meeting Act: The State's Adult Public Guardianship Review Boards meet the definition a "public body," because they were created by State statute, and they are multi-member boards appointed by the chief executive authority a political subdivision. Montgomery County, County Executive appoint the members to the Review Board. However, the Review Board meetings may be conducted in closed sessions when those meetings involve any discussion of specific guardianship cases or other confidential matters. **(Please note that using A.I. is a Violation of County Policy.
