The Community Action Board advocates for policies and programs that help low-income members of the community move towards self-sufficiency. The Board also serves as the governing board for Head Start and the Community Action Agency.

The County Executive seeks applicants of diverse backgrounds to fill one vacancy in the low-income sector of the Board. As required by federal guidelines for Community Action Agencies, low-income representatives must be democratically-elected by a local organization or group, such as a PTA, faith organization, or civic association.
