Apply to serve on Montgomery County's Community Action Board!

The Community Action Board advocates for policies and programs that help low-income members of the community move towards self-sufficiency. The Board also serves as the governing board for Head Start and the Community Action Agency.

The County Executive seeks applicants of diverse backgrounds to fill seven vacancies in low-income and private/nonprofit sectors of the Board. Current members representing the low-income community have the option to reapply to extend their terms. Applicants for the low-income sector must be democratically elected by a local group and submit a letter confirming the election process. Applicants for the private/nonprofit sector of the board must submit a nomination letter from a nonprofit or private organization via email.
