

## Calling all advocates for the lower-income community! Apply to serve on the Montgomery County Community Action Board!

The Community Action Board advocates for policies to address critical issues, including affordable housing, early childhood education, tax credits for lower-income filers, raising wages, work supports, food security, and access to services. The Board serves as the governing body for Head Start and the Community Action Agency.

The County Executive seeks applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, genders, geography, disability, and ethnicity to fill <u>five vacancies in the low-income sector of the Board</u> and <u>two vacancies in the private sector of the Board</u> (one incumbent in each sector is eligible to reapply). Per federal guidelines, low-income sector representatives must be democratically elected by a local group comprised of lower-income residents. Private sector representatives must be nominated by a private organization.
