- Youth employment
- o Community dialogue (creating space for courageous conversations)
- Advocacy (continue examining themes from past CCY years)
- o Homelessness and youth
- o School violence and keeping keeps safe
- o DACA and unaccompanied youth
- Commissioners who proposed priorities had the opportunity to provide some brief background on their suggested topic
- Commissioners were provided the opportunity to vote for their top two priorities:
 - Final value vote included:
 - School violence and keeping kids safe in schools (during school and afterschool)
 - Continuation of the mental wellness priority and work of subcommittee
- Commissioners will form new subcommittees at the September 12th meeting and write statements for the top two priorities
- Full CCY will had the opportunity to vote on the final priorities and priority statements

Subcommittee Breakout Session

- "Promoting Mental Wellness" and "Youth Who Are Undocumented" subcommittees met to discuss recommendations for annual report
- Subcommittees will work to finalize their recommendation during the summer recess and prepare to present rough draft(s) of recommendations at September 12th meeting
