- Mental Health and Wellness: had Dr. Raymond Crowel, Chief of Behavioral Health and Crisis Services as the guest speaker; discussed trends in MC as far as suicide, mental health hospitalizations and substance abuse
- Youth Advisory/Leadership: Youth are working to create a survey/poll about Ride On Bus transportation and students accessibility; also working on planning MLK Day of Service service project
