3.0 Chief's Report - Dr. Travis Gayles

- The County Health Rankings Report has been released. Montgomery County is ranked highest although health disparities continue to exist.
- Public Health Services is developing a MOU with the University of MD for research and development, more expertise and increased course offerings.
- Dr. Gayles is considering how to have more targeted interventions to address health concerns and disparities.

4.0 BCC's Annual Meeting with the County Executive – Heather Deckert

- Heather Deckert and Jason Woo attended the annual meeting with the County Executive.
- The COH did not present as the focus of the meeting was for the County Executive to address questions presented by the BCCs.
- There was a presentation from the County Attorney's Office followed by questions from BCC representatives.
- There were two areas that may be of interest to the COH: 1) Commission on Children & Youth –
 Children's access to mental health services needs to be increased/improved and 2) Alcohol &
 Other Drug Abuse Advisory Council Who is coordinating data throughout the county?
 Advocated for more substance use treatment and services.

 African American Health Program/Michelle Hawkins – AAHP Community Day is Saturday, April 21st at Montgomery College

- Healthy Montgomery (HM)/Michelle Hawkins An overview of the Behavioral Health Strategic Alignment Report was given at the last HM meeting.
- Mental Health Advisory Board/Jessica Kronstadt The Annual Spring Forum "Stigma to Strength" will take place on Thursday, May 3, 2018 at Bohrer Park
- Commission on Children Youth and Families/Brenda Brooks The Commission is considering the best way to conduct outreach to youth via wellness centers or Aps.
- Commission on People with Disabilities/ Kathy Mann Koepke The Commission is working on health disparities, health access, transportation (health care, employment, social activities). They have been successful in increasing the employment of those with disabilities.

 Commissioners should begin to consider if they are interested in serving on one of these committees.

7.0 Workgroup Reports

- Behavioral Health would like more information about the Behavioral Health Strategic Alignment Report and would like to invite Dr. Crowel to a COH meeting.
- Health Literary is continuing to follow up on signage at HHS facilities.
- Data is developing a document to articulate a vision for the health department's data collection and analysis to ensure that the department has the information it needs for decision making.
- Access to Contraception has expanded their focus from solely looking at access to contraception
 to looking at sexual health and education more broadly. They hope to respond to some of Dr.
 Gayles' concerns regarding condoms in schools' initiative and increasing rates of STIs in the
 county.
