	DHHS staff gave an overview of the Healthcare for the Uninsured Report highlighting the slight drop in Montgomery Perinatal Program participation and an ongoing discussion to determine if external impacts are driving down utilization. Continued increases to Care for Kids program participation was also highlighted.			
5.	MCares Quarterly Update See Presentation Dr. Veronica Vela			
6.	 Dr Vela gave an overview of the Montgomery Cares program quarterly report. Highlights: Significant increase in encounters for Montgomery Cares and Care For Kids compared to the budgeted totals for FY25 to date. Billable encounters are approximately 85% of the total budgeted amount for FY25 at the close of the third quarter showing a significant increase in utilization compared to the past few fiscal years. Dr. Vela noted the diverse capabilities, strengths and core competencies of the participating clinics. MCAB member, Mark Foraker pointed out that the growth is not necessarily uniform across all participating clinics. Mark Foraker raised concerns about the need to increase telehealth utilization and suggested clinics consider the need for patient education regarding telehealth utilization. Dr. Vela gave an update on the Specialty Care Improvement project and gave updates on initial findings and the stages remaining for the information gathering phase of the project. Other items covered include capacity limitations for the behavioral health program related to staffing changes and an increase in requests for utilization and a pilot program to test implementing check-in kiosks at some clinic locations that participate in the Montgomery Cares Program. 	Dr. Kelly gave an overview of the discussions that informed the advocacy priorities and resulting draft letter as well as the revision process for the final version detailing the FY26 MCAB priorities. Dr. Kelly solicited additional input regarding the priority letter to the County Council and with no further discussion from the group, she requested a motion to approve the current. Once approved, the letter will be finalized and sent by Ashley Miller to County Council for consideration for the FY26 Budget.
