This is the first in a series of communications that the OHR Health Insurance Team will be sharing to inform you of changes that will be made to the administration of County-sponsored prescription drug coverage for Medicare-eligible retirees effective January 1, 2015.

Dear Montgomery County Government Retiree:

As announced in the March 2014 MCREA newsletter, Medicare-eligible retirees who participate in a County-sponsored Caremark prescription plan will receive prescription drug coverage through a Medicare Part D Employer Group Waiver Plan (EGWP). This plan, effective January 1, 2015, will have a “wraparound” feature (Wrap) to ensure your coverage will continue at current levels. The EGWP+Wrap plan will be administered by SilverScript, which is the Medicare Part D subsidiary of CVS Caremark. While this change applies only to Medicare-eligible retirees, we are also sharing this information with retirees who are not currently eligible for Medicare; that way, they will be aware of the changes that will affect them once they do become Medicare eligible. (Note: This change does not affect Kaiser members.)

A panel discussion regarding the changes will take place during MCREA's annual meeting on June 4, 2014 (7:00 - 9:00 pm); COB 3rd Floor Council Hearing Room. Retirees will have the opportunity to hear about plan details and participate in a Q&A session. If possible, the discussion will be broadcast live; check the News section of www.montgomerycountymd.gov/ohr the day before for an update.
