The training satisfies the required 60 minutes of training on the physical, behavioral, and performance indicators of probable drug use and 60 minutes of training on the physical, behavioral, speech, and performance indicators of probable alcohol misuse under federal regulations (49 CFR 655.14).

- Signs and symptoms of a drug use and alcohol misuse
- Drug and alcohol testing procedures
- Post-accident testing thresholds
- Required forms
