<u>Duration</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 900 hours in 12 –month period not to exceed twenty-four months • Candidates can work 2 – 18/hrs/wk depending on department need and candidate availability. • Flexible work schedule 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interns participate in up to three 10-week, intensive worksite internships supported by SEEC’s job coaches • Interns work approximately 25 hours per week and attend one hour of classroom instruction daily • Program hours: 8:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
<u>Enrollment</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employment available throughout the year based on department need, grant money and vacancies • Candidates must be registered with Worksource Montgomery 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • September to June based on school year calendar • Program model allows for a maximum of 12 interns per year
