Fire Rescue Hazmat Update – Battalion Chief Ivan Browning

- Incidents from 10/2/21 through 1/18/22
 - Total Hazmat Responses – 31
 - Propane – 1
 - Natural Gas – 3
 - Hydrocarbon – 11
 - Chemical Spills/Leak/Inhalation – 9
 - Significant Incidents
 - Gasoline Tractor Trailer T-Bone – Gaithersburg
 - Reported as gasoline leaking but ended up just being diesel from a saddle tank
 - Carbon Dioxide Truck/Facility Leak at Roberts Oxygen – Gaithersburg
 - Truck at outside above ground storage tank had a failure. Hazmat performed recon and entry to stop leak. Worked with facility for termination of incident
