SUBJECT: Final Confidential Advisory Memorandum: *Department of Correction and Rehabilitation Personnel Complaints and Allegations*

The Office of the Inspector General has completed our review of personnel-related complaints and allegations from staff of the Montgomery County Department of Correction and Rehabilitation (DOCR). Our objective in conducting this review, among other things, was to investigate and analyze employee grievances of inequitable or improper treatment, and inform DOCR management of employee concerns.

County Code section 2-151(k) requires that an Office of the Inspector General report must be made public, subject to the state public information act (MPIA). The MPIA, MD Code, General Provisions, Sec. 4-351(a) states, “a custodian may deny inspection of . . . (2) an investigatory file compiled for any other law enforcement, judicial, correctional, or prosecution purpose”. Accordingly, only this memorandum will be distributed to County Councilmembers, made publicly available, and posted to our web site. The full report may, however, be made available confidentially to and discussed with Councilmembers in closed session.
