Montgomery County Office of the Inspector General Releases Annual Report

Rockville, Maryland – Montgomery County Maryland Inspector General Megan Davey Limarzi announced today the release of the Office of the Inspector General's (OIG) <u>Annual Report</u>. The report is required by Montgomery County Code Section 2-151(k)(1) and details the activities of the Office and its major findings and recommendations during the previous fiscal year.

Inspector General Limarzi made the following statement in connection with the publication of the annual report: "I am pleased to present the Office of the Inspector General's (OIG) Annual Report detailing the activities and accomplishments of the OIG during fiscal year 2022. The exceptional work and achievements contained herein are those of a team of professionals dedicated to providing independent, relevant government oversight with integrity and excellence." Inspector General Limarzi touted the OIG's continued efforts to promote accountability in the expenditure of resources and funds in support pandemic-related needs; advance the efficient use and management of data and assets in county government, the Montgomery County Public Schools, and the Housing Opportunities Commission of Montgomery County; and innovations to enhance the OIG's ability to serve those that report information to the office.

Inspector General Limarzi additionally acknowledged the significant investment made by county leadership in the growth and modernization of the OIG over the past three years. That investment and continued support will enable the OIG to provide the quality and level of oversight necessary to promote transparency and trust in county government.
