Dear Ms. Kichter:

The Water Management Administration (WMA) has received and reviewed your request for extension of the above-referenced WQC as well as the associated condition compliance dates. The WQC authorizes the federally permitted impacts of 0.96 acre of waters and wetlands to construct three road crossings and a stormwater management embankment for residential development. The permittee is required to provide 1.92 acres of wetland creation and implement stormwater quality management (SWM) practices to mitigate the authorized impacts as a condition of the WQC.

Since none of the authorized impacts to waters or wetlands have occurred, the WMA extends the WQC expiration, mitigation plan submission and SWM plan submission dates to February 11, 1999, the expiration of the Corps authorization.
