## MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Merit System Protection Board is to oversee the merit system and protect employee and job applicant rights guaranteed under the merit system law.

## BUDGET OVERVIEW

The total recommended FY27 Operating Budget for the Merit System Protection Board is \$392,005, an increase of \$18,622 or 4.99 percent from the FY26 Approved Budget of \$373,383. Personnel Costs comprise 96.56 percent of the budget for one full-time position(s) and one part-time position(s), and a total of 1.75 FTEs. Total FTEs may include seasonal or temporary positions and may also reflect workforce charged to or from other departments or funds. Operating Expenses account for the remaining 3.44 percent of the FY27 budget.

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

### Merit System Oversight

The Merit System Protection Board oversees the merit system and protects employee and job applicant rights guaranteed under the merit system; conducts or authorizes periodic audits of the classification system; comments on any proposed changes in the merit system law or regulations; reviews the need to amend laws or regulations; and adjudicates appeals from grievances, removals, demotions, and suspensions upon request of an employee. Personnel management oversight includes investigations, audits, or

special studies of all aspects of the merit system. The Board also publishes an annual report.
