DESCRIPTION

This project provides for transportation improvements such as intersection modifications, sidewalks, traffic signals, streetlights, etc., necessary for safe pedestrian and vehicular circulation for schools identified in the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Capital Program. One aspect of this project will focus on improving pedestrian walkability by creating a safer walking environment, utilizing selected engineering technologies, and ensuring ADA compliance.

Service Area

Improvements will be implemented Countywide and typically within the walking distance defined by MCPS for different types of schools (elementary, middle, and high schools).

JUSTIFICATION

This project is the result of a task force which includes representatives from the County Executive, County Council, MCPS, M-NCPPC, and the Maryland State Highway Administration. The construction of schools in the County must be supported by off-site transportation improvements to provide safe access. An individual study has been undertaken to identify requirements related to each new school.
