D. Description & Justification
DESCRIPTION
 This project includes funding for WSSC's share of the Blue Plains Wastewater Treatment Plant biosolids handling projects for which construction began after June 30, 1993. Major facilities include: rehabilitation of gravity thickeners; egg-shaped digestion facilities; centrifuge thickener facilities; and additional dewatering facilities. All facilities are sized at 370 MGD.

JUSTIFICATION
Plans & Studies
 The Blue Plains Intermunicipal Agreement of 1985; the WASA Master Plan (1998); EPMC IV Facility Plan (CH2MHILL, 2001); and the DC-WASA Adopted FY 2004 - FY 2013 Capital Improvement Program (January, 2005).

Specific Data
 This project is needed to implement a set of facilities which will provide a permanent biosolids management program for Blue Plains Sludge.
Cost Change
 The net cost decrease in the six-year program reflects the latest estimates from DCWASA for existing and future projects, and is heavily influenced by a number of the larger projects moving through construction, including: Gravity Thickeners and Additional Dewatering facilities. Lower costs are indicated for the Egg-shaped Digestion Facilities because they are moving through design and into construction.

 The project scope has remained the same.
 Project History: This project was first included in the FY95 CIP and includes those Blue Plains solids handling sub-projects where construction commenced after June 30, 1993. As such, these sub-projects are SDC eligible. The project costs shown above are derived from the DCWASA Capital & Operating Budget 10-year forecast of spending and WASA's latest project management data and fully reflect WASA's current cost estimates and expenditure schedules. Given the open-ended nature of the Blue Plains projects, this PDF may not fully reflect the total project costs. These projects are in fact expected to continue indefinitely. Prior expenditures and funding shown in Column 9 are post-intermunicipal Agreement. The funding schedule also indicates the calculated Rockville share of the cost.
