#### Description

This project addresses four aspects of security throughout MCPS, and will serve to protect not only the student and community population, but also the extensive investment in educational facilities, equipment, and supplies in buildings. An FY 2009 appropriation was approved to provide additional funding for new initiatives for the school security program. The initiatives include design and installation of Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) camera systems in all middle schools, the replacement of existing outdated analog CCTV camera systems in all high schools, the installation of a visitor management system in all schools, and the installation of a visitor access system at elementary schools. An FY 2010 appropriation was approved to continue this project. An FY 2011 appropriation was approved to continue the roll out of the new initiatives that began in FY 2009.
