The Executive recommends changes in the project estimates to align them with the amounts proposed by DC Water in its FY 2012-2021 CIP.

As new sub-projects are added to the Blue Plains facility plans, the associated costs will be added to this project. The funding schedule also indicates the calculated Rockville share of the cost.
