About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™, Montgomery County conducted a mailed survey of 5,000 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in May of 2019 and data were collected through July 19, 2019 (see the report, *The National Community Survey: Community Livability Report, Montgomery County, MD, 2019*). The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of County residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, the County made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the County's website. The survey was available online in English, Spanish and Simplified Chinese. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey from June 28, 2019 through July 19, 2019 and 3,211 surveys were received. This report contains the results of this opt-in administration of the web-based survey. These data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of link on the County's website; therefore a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and American Community Survey estimates for adults in Montgomery County.

The results of the weighting scheme for the opt-in survey are presented in the following table.
