Does not feed commuters to National Harbor, Largo/Landover, Greenbelt, Silver Spring, White Oak, White Flint or Bethesda</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourages local economic development. Feeds commuters to local economic development priority hubs.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Destroys 250+ acres of park land including likely Rock Creek Park, Sligo Creek Park, Indian Spring Terrace Park, Northwest Branch Park, Cherry Hill Road Park, Knollwood Park, Powder Mill Park, Greenbelt Park and other local parks.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Preserves local park land</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Delays relief for Frederick County and Montgomery County north of Gaithersburg</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Offers immediate relief for Frederick County and 200,000+ residents of Germantown and Clarksburg</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Violates county master plans</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Advances county master plans and long term growth vision.</li> </ul>
