UNIT LICENSE NO. 149586**

Please take notice that the Office of Zoning and Administrative Hearings for Montgomery County, Maryland (OZAH), will hold a public hearing on Thursday, April 13, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. on the above-captioned Objection to findings of the Director of the Department of Housing and Community Affairs regarding Accessory Dwelling Unit License Application No. 149586. The subject property is located at 3108 Memory Lane, Silver Spring, MD 20904.

Objections to the grant of an Accessory Dwelling Unit License are governed by Section 29-26 of the Montgomery County Code and [OZAH's Rules of Procedure for Agency Referral and Accessory Dwelling Units](#). OZAH's Rules may be found on the above website.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this hearing will be held remotely via Microsoft Teams. You do not need to sign up in advance to testify or view the hearing. You do not need a subscription to Microsoft Teams to join the hearing. Instructions to access the public hearing may be found under the link “Public Hearing Remote Access and Exhibits” and the Hearing Calendar on OZAH’s website (above) at least two days before the public hearing.

All exhibits filed in the case will be available to view via the link “Public Hearing Remote Access and Exhibits” on OZAH’s website at least two days before the public hearing. Exhibits are removed the day after the public hearing so that staff can prepare for the next hearing. If you wish to download any of the exhibits, you should do so no later than 5:00 p.m. of the day of the public hearing.

OZAH is now operating remotely to the extent possible. If you wish to review the full file (all submission in the case) before it is published on the website or have other questions, please contact Nana Johnson at (240) 777-6663 or nana.johnson@montgomerycountymd.gov.

Any parties represented by counsel must submit electronic copies of their supporting documents prior to the hearing. Electronic copies must be submitted on compact discs, in Microsoft WORD format for text documents, and in PDF format for plans and other non-text documents.

In compliance with Maryland requirements regarding the practice of law, groups or associations must have counsel unless their witnesses are members of the group or association who will offer testimony in narrative form (*i.e.*, there is no need for an attorney to conduct a direct examination).
