Director Byrne:

This letter is submitted on behalf of Caressa D. Bennet, Roger D. Winston, Dan P. Chappell, Frederic Malek, Britlan Malek, Kenneth E. Mack, David R. Goodfriend and Alexandre Finkel (collectively "Objectors") who have filed objections to the above referenced ADU license application, and is to request a postponement of the OZAH hearing on their objections. The OZAH hearing is supposed to be scheduled within 30 days of OZAH's receipt of an objection, but Objectors have multiple conflicts with the possible OZAH hearing dates that fall within that 30 day time period. However, Nana Johnson has reported the hearing could be scheduled during the week of December 9.

Nana Johnson has advised that December 9 or 10 are available, and certain Objectors are able to attend a hearing on one of those dates.

Because this matter involves a decision of a County agency, I believe that Section 2A-7 (a)(i) of the County Code applies and the Department of Housing and Community Affairs ("DHCA") is required to submit its record on ADU License Application No. 151423 to OZAH for its hearing twenty (20) days before the OZAH hearing. If Section 2A-7 (a)(i) is not applicable, this letter is to request that OZAH request that the DHCA voluntarily file its complete file, or a complete and accurate copy of its file, on ADU License Application No. 151423 with OZAH no later than twenty (20) days before the OZAH hearing. Alternatively, the Objectors request that DHCA be subpeonaed to file its complete record on the application with OZAH no later than twenty (20) days before the OZAH hearing.

Notwithstanding OZAH's hybrid office hours, the Objectors want to visit OZAH's office to review and copy all, or parts of, the DHCA file before the hearing.
