Hello, I have just received your certified letter requesting a response complaint. The letter was mailed to my office location, not my home. Being physically disabled, I don't check the office mail location regularly. But I have it now and will treat it importantly and with speed.

I read it preliminary and let me mention:

1. I have never been presented with any doctor's communication of a disability for anyone.
2. The defendant's history has invaded my privacy by recording me and placing it onto a public website, so I am now strictly following Maryland law regarding private meetings -- which include all Leisure World governance mtgs.
3. A complaint of a similar nature by this complainant has previously been brought to MD state legal authorities and been denied.
4. personally, I was born with a progressive physical disability and have been on SSDI for ten years. I am quite sensitive to any need, and am familiar with ADA regs. For instance, her physician can identify the need for accommodation, but not the accomodation itself.

I will respond as requested asap.
