I am writing as a longtime neighbor of Holton-Arms School and the parent of three daughters who have attended the school to express my support for Holton's request to amend its special exception.

I live on Royal Dominion Court across River Road from the school, so I am very familiar with the daily traffic patterns around the school and along River Road. From my perspective, the school has consistently managed traffic in an organized and efficient manner. Morning drop-offs and afternoon pick-ups are well-coordinated, and I have not observed the congestion or cut-through traffic that some have suggested. In my view, Holton's operations have never posed an inconvenience to our neighborhood.

Because I have seen how smoothly things run, I am confident that the proposed change of allowing a modest increase in enrollment and limited facility rentals, will not have a negative impact on traffic or neighborhood safety. The school has always taken its responsibility as a good neighbor seriously, and I have no doubt that it will continue to do so.

Holton-Arms is a valued part of our community and has been an important part of my family's life. Its students, faculty, and families contribute positively to the area, and its thoughtful planning and communication give me full confidence in this request.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge you to approve Holton-Arms School's amendment to its special exception.
