



## Autism/ID Elopement 911 "Script"

The below 911 script is to be filled out ahead of time by caregivers of individuals with Autism/ID. In the event of an elopement, caregivers can easily relay the important information to the 911 call taker and responding officers.

Please print out and include with your 911 script a Google map of the area around your home and pin point any potential dangers or possible destinations your child may be drawn towards in the event of an elopement.**
