FRS is requesting a three month extension beyond the term of the contract with a ten day kickout clause. A replacement solicitation has already closed, and FRS is preparing to submit the new contract package in the near future. The department expects the new contract to be in place prior to the end of the three month extension.

# Background

MCG Contract No. 1090641 was executed on July 26, 2018, for an initial period of one year with three additional, one-year renewal options. The Auto Barn, Inc. provides towing, transport, and recovery of fixed-route transit buses, heavy duty trucks, and construction equipment, as required and upon request of the Department of General Services, Division of Fleet Management Services (DFMS). DFMS has exercised a one-year extension beyond the term at the approval of CRC, which expires on July 25, 2024. Procurement received a protest appeal from one of the bidders which has caused a delay in awarding the contract for replacement solicitation, IFB# 1156052. In the meantime, it is essential that the current contract remains in place to meet the towing needs and requirements of the Transit and Heavy Equipment Fleet until a replacement contract is executed.

### **Background**

DHHS is requesting to modify the approval of a new non-competitive Sole Source contract scope that was approved in 2023. These modifications will provide renovations to 3 floors of the facility to include patient rooms and bathrooms, dining room, lobby, and offices so the facility will be fully operational. The annual proposed costs for this Contract will remain the same at approximately \$3,270,000 per year and add estimated start-up costs of \$832,000 for the renovations.
