


Holy Cross Germantown Hospital



- Opened October 1st!
- Anchor of Montgomery College Life Science Park
- First new hospital in Montgomery County in 35 years.
- Emergency Department averaging 53 visits/day – higher than expected
- Behavioral Health Unit (6 private room) been full for last several days




Montgomery College Germantown Bioscience Education Center

- **Opened September 10, 2014**
- **Includes: classrooms, laboratories, offices, greenhouse complex and conference center**
- **Supports biology, biotechnology, chemistry, ecology and genetics curriculum**
- **LEED Gold-certified center**



Upcounty Parks

- Germantown Town Center Urban Park:
 - Construction began Spring 2012 and expected completion Winter 2014/15
- Little Bennett Regional Park Day Use Area
 - Design in FY17 & FY18
 - Construction beginning in FY19
- Ovid Hazen Wells Recreational Park
 - Master Plan update: expected Planning Board Final Review/Adoption Winter 2014/15

Fall 2014/2015: FTA project development phase


Winter 2015/2016: Initiate design activities

Dependent on funding:


Spring 2018: Begin construction


Spring 2021: Begin operations






Mid-County Highway Corridor Study(M-83)

- A draft Environmental Impact Statement was completed Spring 2013
- A public hearing was held by the US Army Corps of Engineers in August 2013
- Department of Transportation to submit an environmental impact report to federal agencies by October 2014
- No funding in CIP beyond preliminary design




Roadways and Walkways

- **Clarksburg Transportation Connections:**

- Snowden Farm Parkway north of Morning Star Drive to Ridge Road (MD 27)
- Little Seneca Parkway from Snowden Farm Parkway to Frederick Road (MD 355)
- Brink Road intersection


Project to be constructed by the developers
Funding CIP: FY16-FY20



Roadways and Walkways


- **Ridge Road (MD 27)**

- 6 lanes divided roadway from Brink Rd to Snowden Farm Parkway
- Transitions to 2 lane road (existing) at Snowden Farm Parkway and Skylark Road
- Arora Hills frontage (Little Seneca Parkway to Skylark Road) also 2 lane roadway with turn lanes and acceleration/deceleration lanes
- Traffic light and “full intersection” installed at intersection Ridge/Little Seneca next summer




Stringtown Road

- Reconstruct the existing $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, two lane section as a four-lane divided roadway
- Design complete
- Currently working with County Executive and Elm Street to get this project underway
- Exploring options to find resources to expedite this road project



Roadways and Walkways

- **Observation Drive Extended:**
 - Design/Land Acquisition: Summer 2019 – Summer 2023; Construction after FY20
- **W Old Baltimore Rd/MD 355 Intersection:**
 - In design phase
- **Frederick Road Bike Path:**
 - Design/Land Acquisition currently underway
 - Utility relocations FY16 – FY17
 - Construction to begin FY16, completion FY17
- **MD 355 Sidewalk (Hyattstown):**
 - Construction begins Spring 2015




Upcounty Development

Clarksburg:

- **Gallery Place:** Under construction
- **Tapestry:** Approved, construction not yet started
- **Cabin Branch Residential:** Approved (all 5 phases), construction has started
- **Courts of Clarksburg:** Pending, 140 senior housing units
- **Dowdens Station:** Pending, 109 units


Clarksburg Premium Outlets

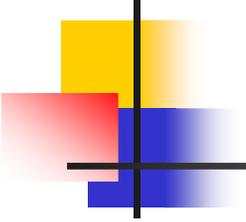
- Upzoned to encourage development and stimulate growth



 - School opened August 2014!
- **Clarksburg High School: 18-Classroom Addition**
 - Completion August 2015
- **Clarksburg/Damascus MS: New**
 - Scheduled completion August 2016
- **Neelsville MS: Classroom Addition**
 - FY2015 funds approved for planning
- **Clarksburg Cluster ES #8: New**
 - FY2015 funds approved for planning
- **Captain James E. Daly ES: Classroom Addition**
 - Facility planning done; not in CIP at this time




Damascus and Northwest School Cluster

Damascus:

 - Scheduled completion January 2023


