Hi Andrew - hope all is well. From my recollection and file records, please see my responses below.

1) Gude Landfill Waste Delineation Study January 2010 [The County never received a letter from MDE approving this Report. We would like a letter if MDE is willing to prepare one.]

2) Gude Landfill Nature and Extent Study (NES) Report November 2010 [The County never received a letter from MDE approving this Report. If you recall, MDE and the County held a Meeting in February 2011, which resulted in the County generating meeting minutes and a MDE Comment/County Response Document regarding the Nov. 2010 NES Report. MDE provided a letter approving the meeting minutes and the Comment/Response Document, which was referred to as "Amendment No.1" to the NES. I will get you a copy of this letter. The County does not require an additional letter for the Nov. 2010 NES Report, since we recently received an approval letter from MDE regarding the NES Amendment No.1 Report.]

* 3) Gude Landfill Remediation Feasibility Memorandum January 2011 [The County never received a letter from MDE approving this Memorandum. As clarified in the February 2011 meeting on the NES, the Remediation Feasibility Memorandum was prepared as a due diligence effort by the County to review available technologies and processes that may help the County with site compliance issues at the Gude Landfill and to satisfy a request from the Gude Landfill Concerned Citizens. We provided a copy to MDE to see if there were any objections to the potential technologies or processes that the County evaluated, since they would likely be basis for the future Assessment of Corrective Measures (ACM). Regarding a letter from MDE on this Memorandum, it may make more sense for MDE to just reference the Memorandum, during the review and approval process of our upcoming ACM Work Plan. I will leave this decision to your discretion.]

I will scan and provide the above referenced letter in Item 2 on Tuesday.
