

NOTICE TO ALL SOLID WASTE HAULERS

Chapter 48, Sections 19-30, of the Montgomery County Code, requires anyone transporting solid waste within Montgomery County, Maryland be licensed. Listed below are the necessary instructions and a list of licensing requirements. If you have any questions, please contact the Licensing Program at 240-777-6565.

The following documentation is required to apply for a HAULERS license.

- ✓ Application Form. The form must be completed and signed by the applicant or the applicant's agent.

Business Address: The office must be located in Montgomery County or you must provide a local telephone number or a toll-free telephone number.
- ✓ Solid Waste Vehicle Registration Application: One form must be submitted per vehicle and/or trailer.
- ✓ Legible copy of the State Vehicle Registration Card: Must be submitted for each vehicle to be permitted. Please note: if a truck is leased, then a copy of the lease agreement between lessee and lessor must be submitted along with the rest of the application. The lease agreement should include the vehicle(s) information (state tag, year, make, model and VIN) and clearly indicate which company will be responsible for: licensing, maintenance and enforcement.
- ✓ Consolidated list of trucks: If two or more vehicles will be permitted: the list should include; fleet number, state tag, year, make, model and VIN.
- ✓ Fees: The fee for the Solid Waste Collector license is \$25.00. Solid waste vehicle permits are \$5.00 per vehicle. Please make your check(s) payable to Montgomery County, Maryland. These fees do not include disposal fees.

Expirations. The Solid Waste Collector licenses expires one (1) year from the date of issuance. Vehicle permits will expire the SAME month as the Solid Waste Collector License.

Solid Wastes Law. You are responsible for following the provisions of Montgomery County, Maryland, Solid Wastes Law; located on www.amlegal.com/montgomery_county_md/. (Click on NO FRAMES). Search Chapter 48.

Solid Waste Tonnage Report. This data is required by the State of Maryland and must be submitted semi-annually. If you have any questions, please contact **Jeanne Risher (240)777-6434**.

Solid Waste Disposal Account. If you can guarantee that you will dispose at least 20 tons per month of solid waste at Montgomery County's Shady Grove Processing Facility and Transfer Station, you may qualify for a Disposal Account. **For further information contact Jeanne Risher (240) 777-6434.**

NOTE: The Licensing Program DOES NOT accept incomplete packages. Please follow the check list above to make sure all documents are submitted accordingly. Incomplete applications will be returned. Copies must be legible. Faxes will not be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.
