- 2. Approval of the AAC Minutes from April 15, 2014. (See Attachment A.)
- 3. Update on the FY15 Operating and Capital Budgets as follows:

Total personnel costs associated with the MLS Manager II position-Jeremy Criss has been approved for migration back to Operating Budget reducing expenses charged to the Capital Budget.

Vacant Business Development Specialist I position-(Kristin Fisher) approved to be filled and funded out of the Operating Budget.

Operating Funding for increasing technical assistance to farmers (FAME report)-Hire a part-time contractor Agronomy Educator assigned to UM-Extension for Montgomery County only.

Appropriation of a State Grant-Rural Legacy Program-7th Grant Agreement between DNR and the County-\$400,000.

New funding \$320,000 allocated to MSCD for technical assistance to farmers (FAME report)-WQPC funding to reinstate the Resource Conservationist-Brian Taylor position. The WQPC funding will also fund .1FTE for the Resource Conservationist –Eddie Franceschi and .1FTE for the Program Manager-David Plummer. This outcome will eliminate the need for the MSCD to provide \$20,000 in private contributions to the County DED in the future. The WQPC funding will also fund the Best Management Practices Incentive Programs. Please note the Leadership from Council Member Roger Berliner was the reason this request for funding to the MSCD was approved by the Council. (See Attachment B.)

- 4. Update on Farm Equipment Share Program Discussions with MCFB and MSCD-Insurance Requirements.
- 5. Update on Farmland Preservation Easement Purchase Period February-April 1, 2014-We have enough funding for 14. Base BLT price is \$222,000 per BLT and Maximum BLT Price is \$254,000. John Z has received BLT applications for 23 BLTs and believes that 20 may be eligible and ranked. The APAB will recommend ranking on May 20, 2014.
- 6. Good turn out of 55 people for the Public Workshop for High Tunnels and Greenhouses scheduled April 29, 2014.
- 7. Good turn out 45 people for the May 7, 2014 7:00 pm The Montgomery Food Council-Meet Your Agricultural Producer event at the Agricultural History Farm Park. **Presentations by David Heisler, Greg Glen, and Linda Lewis were very well received and greatly appreciated by those that attended.**
- 8. Proposed Amendments to Chapter 5 Animal Control-Equestrian Facilities- recommended by the AAC to address the conflicts in County Code Chapter 59 Zoning.
