- 3. <u>Update on the Farm Alcohol Production Facilities</u>-FAPF-The DPS and OAG are working on another proposed Farm Brewery. They have an existing tap room in the Gaithersburg, and they have a contract to purchase a farm in the Agricultural Reserve for new production facility and future tap room.
- 4. The Agritourism Study Advisory Committee-ASAC met on Tuesday October 29, 2019. The Study and Final report will be presented to the Montgomery County Planning Board on December 19, 2019. The County Council will receive the Study and Report after the holidays. We are not sure what the County Council will do on the Study and Final report. A Zoning Text Amendment is recommended to improve the definition of Agricultural Education and Tourism. Jeremy met with members of the League of Women Voters Agriculture Committee to discuss agritourism including their concerns.

- 6. The University of Maryland Extension made a job offer regarding the David Gordon's 4-H Livestock position. The new employee will start in December.
