
Please call the property owners at least three days in advance for complete instructions on access and parking.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- Montgomery County has a 93,000 acre (1/3 of the Land Area) Agricultural Reserve that affords residents the opportunity to buy food locally from farmers who live and work here, enjoy recreational opportunities such as biking, hunting and fishing as well as learn about the agricultural heritage of this area
- Agriculture contributes \$282 million to the County's economy
- There are 558 farms and 350 horticultural enterprises across the County
- In 2024, Manna purchased 135,170 lbs. of produce, meat, and eggs from County farmers. 19,144 of those lbs., or roughly 14%, were culturally considerate crops such as kale, snake gourd, and bok choy

Depending on the type of cheese, it's aged in our aging room before being distributed to local wineries, breweries, specialty cheese shops, grocers, and restaurants. On Farm Tour days, we will provide visitors the opportunity to pet the goats, tour our dairy operation, and see the goat cheese production process through our large viewing window.
