




Everything from arugula to yarn is abundantly available and ready to go home with you.

We hope you'll take this opportunity to visit a farm close to you or better yet several farms around the County. Montgomery County's rich agricultural heritage is here to greet you on our farms and in our products.

1. Becraft's Farm Produce, Inc., 14722 New Hampshire Ave., Silver Spring. We are part of Montgomery County roots and have farmed this land for 60 years. **Blueberries, Peaches, Tomatoes, Squash, Limas, Beans, Corn, Cantaloupes, Honey, Jams.**
2. Beall's Shropshires, 22630 Ridge Rd., Germantown. Ninian Beall founded Georgetown and Bealls have been here ever since. We know a good thing! **Shropshire Breeding Stock, Market Lambs, Holland Lop & Dwarf Rabbits, Sheep & Rabbit Manure.**
3. Butler's Orchard, 22200 Davis Mill Rd., Germantown. For generations Montgomery has been coming to us for luscious pick-your-own produce. **Vegetables, Peaches, Flowers, Preserves, Honey.**
4. Catoctin Vineyard, Inc., 805 Greenbridge Rd., Brookeville. Montgomery's only winery offers tours and tastings. **Table Wine.**
5. Cherry Glen Farm, 16120 Barnesville Rd., Boyds. Typical of Montgomery's new farmers, we cleared our land and established a working farm in less than a decade. **Champion Dairy Goats, Suffolk Sheep & Market Lambs, Hi-Tensile Electric Fencing.**
6. Frozen Levels Farm, 24445 River Rd., Dickerson. We feature the lovely, pastoral sight of Black Angus in a green pasture. **Timothy Hay, Orders for Beef.**
7. Horizon Farm, 23000 Shiloh Church Rd., Boyds. A father-and-sons- operation, we grow our own on 20 acres of extensively managed cropland with one of the best views in Montgomery. **Houseplants, Vegetables, Fruits, Shrubs, Christmas Trees.**
8. Query Mill Hill Organic Farm, 13231 Query Mill Rd., Gaithersburg. Our organic acre produces so abundantly we go to market every week. Ask us how we do it with no commercial fertilizer, herbicide or pesticides. **Fruits, Vegetables.**
9. Oak Hill, 7920 Brink Rd., Laytonsville. On a rolling hillside by a briskly flowing stream, our beef steers graze contentedly, creating a pretty picture. **Orders for beef.**
10. Paul's Patch, 805 Greenbridge Rd., Brookeville. Sharing a farm with Catoctin Vineyard, we offer pick-your-own produce. **Raspberries, Blueberries, Tomatoes, Flowers, Grapes.**
11. Pleasant Springs, 16112 Barnesville Rd., Renaissance crafts in a 1768 log cabin, produce from a settler's garden, pet sheep. **Yarn, sheepskin Hats & Dusters, Market Lambs, Herbs, Flowers, Beans, Squash.**
12. Pretty Penny Farm, 21513 New Hampshire Ave., Brookeville. Picturesque, historic working farm with a gracious farmhouse and 19th century farm buildings. **Sweet Corn, Tomatoes, Hay & Straw, Firewood.**
13. Rock Hill Orchard, 28600 Ridge Rd., Mt. Airy. Just inside Montgomery, we offer pick-your-own as well as produce from a handsome farm market. **Peaches, Blackberries, Flowers, Vegetables.**
14. Roslyn Farm, 20401 New Hampshire Ave., Brinklow. Visit and choose your Christmas Tree from our 20-year-old plantation of white pine, blue spruce, scotch pine, douglas & frazer firs. **Christmas trees, Market Lambs, Wool, sheepskins, Beef Orders.**
15. Seneca Creek Farm, 16420 Darnestown Rd., Boyds. Visit one of Montgomery's top rated young farmers on a historic farm with a Seneca sandstone home. **Sweet Corn, Tomatoes, Peppers, Squash, Hay & Straw.**
