

Montgomery County Animal Services & Adoption Center: Adopter Pre-Visit Prep Checklist

At the time of your visit, will you be prepared to take an animal home within 24 hours of adoption approval, which could be the same day as your visit?

No – Feel free to come in during open hours and browse the animals we have to offer. When you are ready to adopt, follow the rest of the checklist below.

Yes – Great! A Counselor looks forward to meeting with you. Please make sure you bring the following items for your visit:

- Driver's License or other government issued ID
 - A lease or closing statement as secondary identification verification *if the address on your ID is not your current address*
- Lease with Pet Addendum if you rent (make sure the pet addendum lists the kind and number of animals allowed, with breed restrictions if applicable)
 - OR A Letter of Authorization from homeowners allowing the type, breed, and number of pets you are applying for *if there is no formal lease*
- Rabies vaccination certificates for all dogs, cats, or ferrets in your home (if applicable)

No need to bring along your existing pets. If a dog to dog introduction is necessary, we will set an appointment for you to return with your pet.
