EIS Process Update


- The Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was formally released via the Federal Register on Friday July 19, 2013 and was available for public review and comment until August 19, 2013
- The Record of Decision (ROD) was signed by the Navy on August 29, 2013. The Federal Register Notification was published on September 10, 2013.
 - Comments on the Final EIS addressed in ROD (pages 25-26)
- The EIS process officially closed with the signing of the ROD and subsequent Federal Register notification.




Proposed Action Summary Medical Facilities Development

- Demolition of five hospital buildings (Buildings 2, 4, 6, 7, 8) and construction of a 5-story replacement facility in the same footprint
- Construction of a 500-space parking garage on H-Lot to provide a net increase of 500 patient/visitor/VIP spaces in the hospital core
- Utility capacity upgrades
- Construction of temporary medical facilities to maintain uninterrupted patient care during construction
- Internal renovations of five hospital buildings (Buildings 1, 3, 5, 9, 10)
- Accessibility and appearance improvement projects










Proposed Action Summary University Expansion

- Construction of a 341,000 SF education/research facility
 - Alternative Site 2 is the selected location
- Construction of a 400-space staff parking garage
- Internal renovations to existing USU buildings






Updates from the Draft EIS

- Parking garage location changed from Front Lawn (underground) to H-Lot (above ground)
- Building 13 Renovations removed from the project
- Programmatic Agreement with MD State Historic Preservation Office completed for Building C







Next Steps/Construction Update

- Two Medical Facilities Development Projects to begin in Fall 2013
 - Temporary Medical Facilities in G-Lot (2 phases)
 - Accessibility and Appearance Projects
- Two Medical Facilities Development Projects to begin in 2014
 - H-Lot Parking Garage
 - Utility and Electrical Capacity Upgrades
- Building C Demolition/Construction to begin in 2015
