At its meeting of March 24, 2004, the Montgomery County TTFCG voted to recommend the following applications:

- T-Mobile application to install nine 54" panel antennas at the 150' level on the side of the 153' Aldon building located at 8200 Wisconsin Avenue in Bethesda (Application #200403-01).
- T-Mobile application to attach nine 54" panel antennas to the penthouse walls at the 55' level atop an existing 42' building located at 11900 Parklawn Drive in Bethesda (Application #200403-03).
- T-Mobile application to install nine 54" panel antennas at the 50' level on the penthouse on the 40' Core building located at 12800 Middlebrook Road in Germantown (Application #200403-04).
- T-Mobile application to install three 54" panel antennas at the 58' level on the support columns of an existing bell tower at St. Patrick's Church located at 4101 Norbeck Road in Rockville (Application #200403-05).
- Cingular Wireless application to attach six 48" panel antennas at the 115' level of the 125' Barnhart property monopole located at Hawkins Creamery Road & Laytonsville Road in Gaithersburg (Application #200403-06).
- Cingular Wireless application to attach six 48" panel antennas on the roof at the 135' level and on the penthouse walls at the 160' level on the 125' Claridge House Apartments located at 2445 Lyttonsville Road in Silver Spring (Application #200403-07).
