Timothy C. Price graduated from The University of Georgia School of Law in 1989. While in law school, he served on the editorial board of the Georgia Journal of International and Comparative Law and on the managing board as an articles editor. Mr. Price received his Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Georgia State University in 1984.

A native of Georgia, Mr. Price practiced law in Atlanta, Georgia following law school. Tim and his family moved to Chevy Chase Maryland in 2001 and Tim joined Ethridge, Quinn, Kemp, McAuliffe, Rowan & Hartinger. He became a partner in the firm in 2006.
