SUBJECT: Briefing: Community Engagement Officers and Restorative Justice

PURPOSE: Briefing – No Vote Expected

Today the Committee will receive an update on the Community Engagement Officer program as well as Restorative Justice practices within Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS).

Background

School safety is essential for high-quality instruction and overall student and staff well-being. In 2018, Maryland enacted the Safe to Learn Act, which established statewide standards for school safety. Broadly, it requires each public school to have a School Resource Officer (SRO)

or ensure “adequate local law enforcement coverage.” The Act also requires certain SRO training and mandates the establishment of behavioral threat assessment teams that help identify students who may pose a safety threat to schools.¹

In 2020, after student and community advocates requested the modification or end of the SRO program, the Board of Education launched a workgroup to “explore and benchmark alternative discipline program processes used to handle school-based incidents.” The Board’s report was initially due in January 2021, but was postponed until June 2021. Before the Board issued a final report, the County Executive announced his intention to remove SROs from schools.²

Stakeholders created multiple workgroups that studied the issue and made recommendations to improve school climate and the SRO program. These groups included the Student Wellbeing Action Group (SWAG) and Reimagining School Safety and Student Well-Being (RSSSW). By the start of the 2021-2022 school year, police and MCPS implemented the new Community Engagement Officer (CEO) program with a revised Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), including the following changes:

- SROs are now called CEOs;
- They are not to be stationed on school grounds;
- MCPS must call 911 or the Police non-emergency number for service and may not contact the CEO directly;
- There is a clear assumption that the vast majority of student infractions will be handled by MCPS;
- There is a clear framework of the types of infractions that:
 - require MCPS to notify police;
 - give MCPS discretion to notify police; and
 - should be handled solely by MCPS.

At the same time, MCPS worked to establish a restorative justice disciplinary framework that seeks to ensure school safety by fostering physical, social, psychological, and academic well-being through building community, self-care, and resolving conflict. This approach recognizes that infractions will take place but works to repair harm and reintegrate students back into the schools. Teachers, administrators, school-based restorative justice coaches, and student well-being teams work together to provide a tailored approach to each event.

In January 2022, there was a student-involved shooting at Magruder High School. This tragic incident underscored growing parent and student concern about school safety amidst various reports of significant fights and weapons on different school campuses. As a result, MCPS, MCPD, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), and other stakeholders slightly changed the existing CEO program, and renamed it CEO 2.0. The new model increased CEO presence on campus at the discretion of individual schools, thereby making CEOs more visible and providing opportunities for non-enforcement engagement and relationship building. not a return to the prior SRO program, but it does provide some limited opportunities for preventive policing.³

Data

This year, there has been growing concern among parents, students, and other school community members about overall school safety, including opioid overdoses, bias incidents, violence, and weapons. Some students have expressed concern about “bathroom culture” at schools, and MCPS recently issued guidance on current efforts to address this aspect of school safety.⁴ Additionally, parents and students have expressed grave concern about the increase in bias incidents in the school.⁵ Further, recent disciplinary data show that 2021-2022 disciplinary rates showed increased racial and ethnic disparities.⁶

The CEO 2.0 program has an authorized complement of 29 CEO and supervisors. They are provided by MCPD and allied agencies, including Rockville City, Gaithersburg City, the Sheriff, and Park Police. Of the 24 MCPD officers, 10 are female, 11 are Black, nine are white, and four are Latino. There are currently two vacancies, both of which are MCPD. More information on CEOs and assignments are provided on ©81-90.

Calls to Police and Fire: During the first half of this school year, MCPS called Police or Fire 11,211 times. The Emergency Communications Center (ECC) has established a dedicated line for the schools to call, but schools may also call either 911 or the Police non-emergency number. MCPD has provided an itemized list by school on © 2-79 and Fire and Rescue has provided an itemized list by school for all fire and EMS incidents on © 91-96.

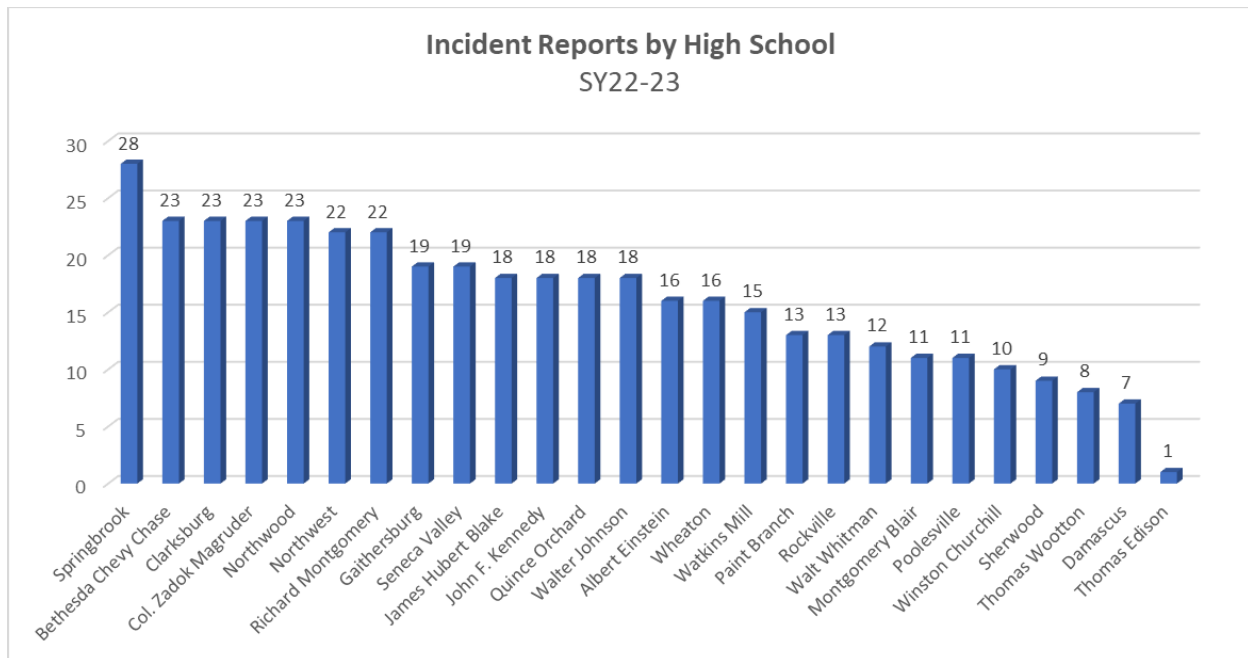

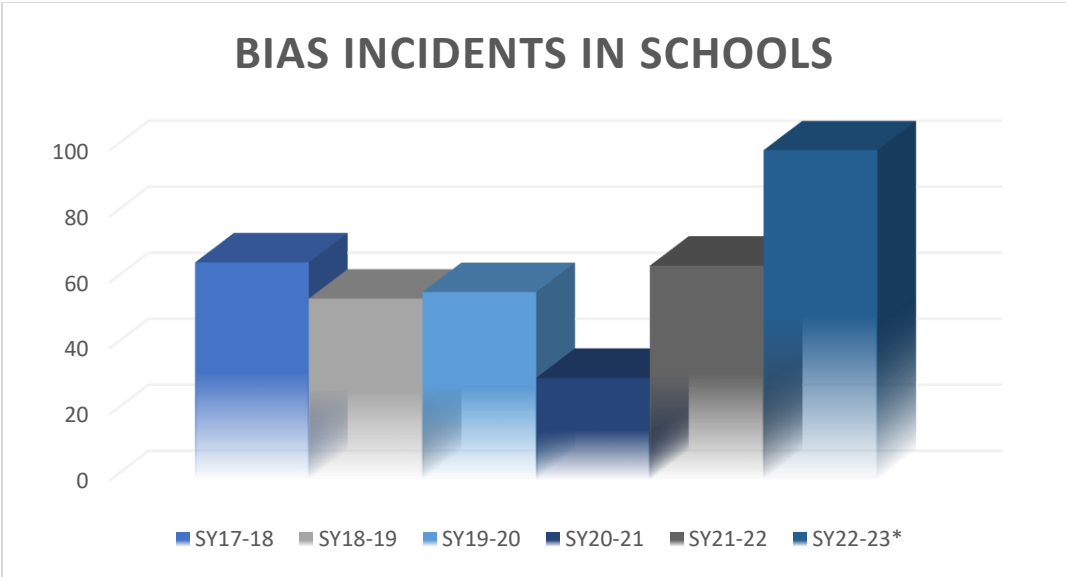

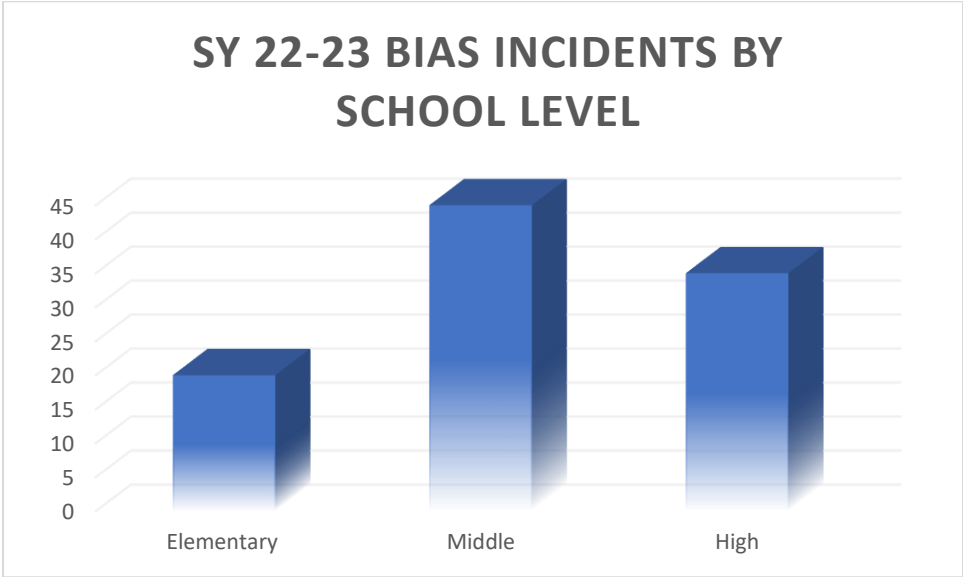
Of those reports, Police or CEOs have conducted 13 arrests and 15 referrals to Department of Juvenile Services (DJS).

Bias Incidents: MCPS reports that there have been 100 reported bias incidents in the schools this year, up from 65 total for all last school year. In February alone, there were 42 incidents.

Disciplinary Outcomes: When looking at selected infractions that resulted in suspensions, overall totals are low, with 2,392 for School Year 2021-2022,⁷ but racial and ethnic disparities remain.

Discussion Issues

1. This year, there are two new Park Police CEOs at Wheaton High School. When were Park Police added to the program? Are they signatories on the current MOU, or does MCPD have a separate MOU with the Park Police?
2. MCPD surveyed some CEOs about their current work status, and “most” responded that they have been invited back into high schools, although some are prohibited from entering elementary or middle schools. How many is “most?” Of those who have been invited back into high schools, what types of activities are they participating in?
3. How many weapons have been recovered from schools this year? How many firearms?
4. In terms of restorative justice, there are gender disparities in referrals to social workers or the wellness centers. Additionally, boys are suspended at significantly higher rates. Does MCPS disaggregate data by gender across all indicators? Are there any patterns that may suggest additional or different supports may be helpful for boys?
5. Before the pandemic, kids 12-18 were more likely to be victims of violence or theft at school rather than away from school. While the overall victimization rates are low (30 per 1,000 students at school vs. 20 per 1,000 students away from school), there are both gender and racial disparities in victimization.⁸ Does MCPS track victimization data by race and gender?
6. Bias incidents are much higher this year than last, and of the 100 incidents reported, 42 occurred in February. Have MCPS or MCPD identified any underlying reasons for such a significant increase?

Most of the CEOs have been invited into their respective high schools by the Principals. Some CEOs report not being able to enter certain Elementary Schools or Middle Schools. The CEOs are reactive and not proactive in this position. Plus, they are now spread out as their responsibilities have increased from one school to several in their assigned cluster.

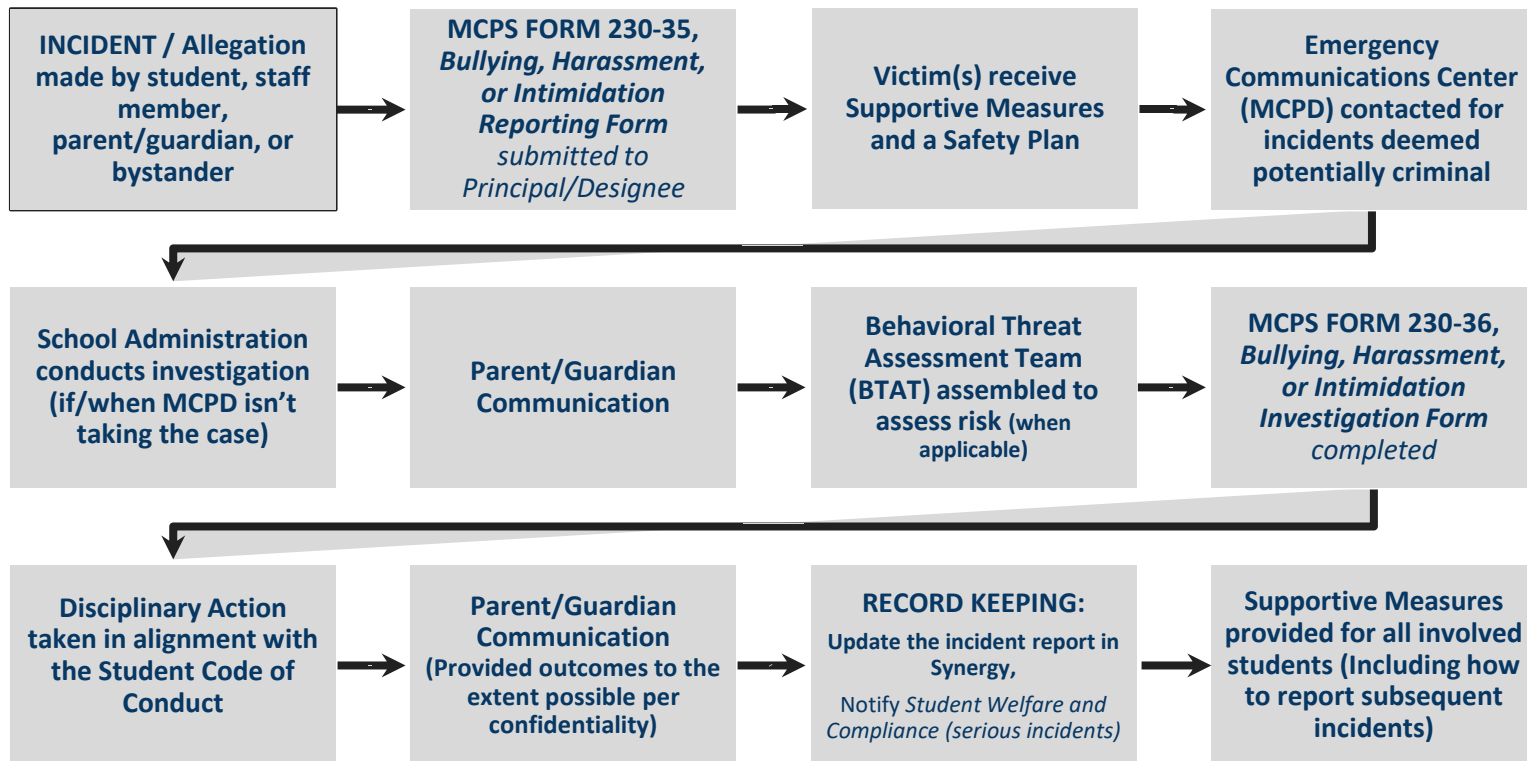

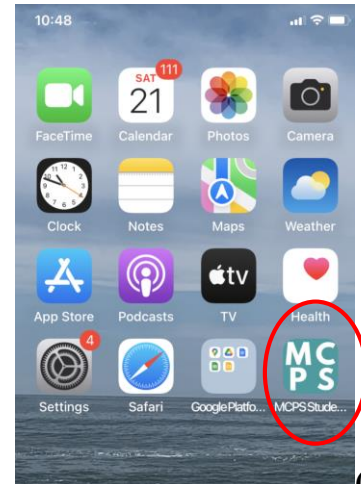
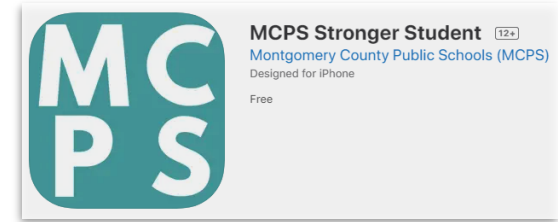

Evaluating A Restorative School Community

Restorative Justice District and School Evaluation Tools

- In October 2022, the Maryland State Department of Education created a tool in order to evaluate the implementation of restorative approaches across school districts.
- MCPS modified this tool to align with the strategic priorities and findings in the antiracist audit.
- Each school, led by the restorative justice coach will conduct an evaluation using the rubric in first quarter 2023.

As of January 31, 2023 with 87 schools reporting:

- **9.2% Reactive:** Minimal preventative measures are in place.
- **64.4% Early:** Limited preventative measures are in place.
- **23% Intermediate:** Proactive measures are in place with moderate effectiveness.
- **3.4% Mature:** Proactive measures are in place with significant effectiveness.

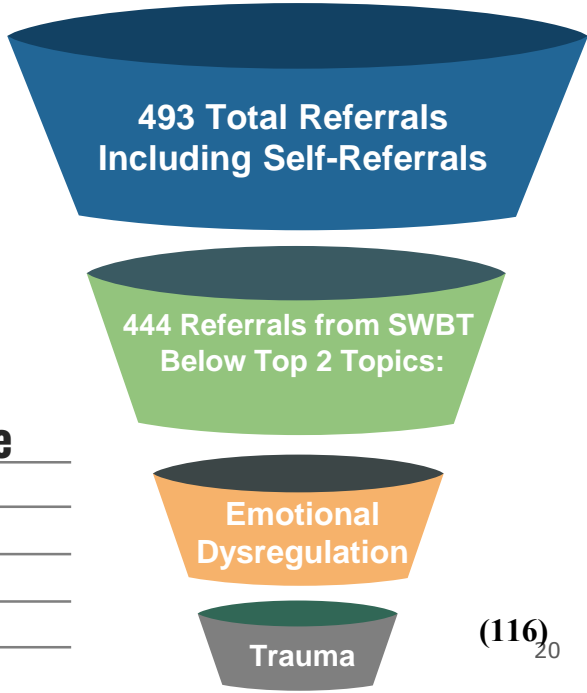
SWBT and Self-Referrals by Race & Ethnicity

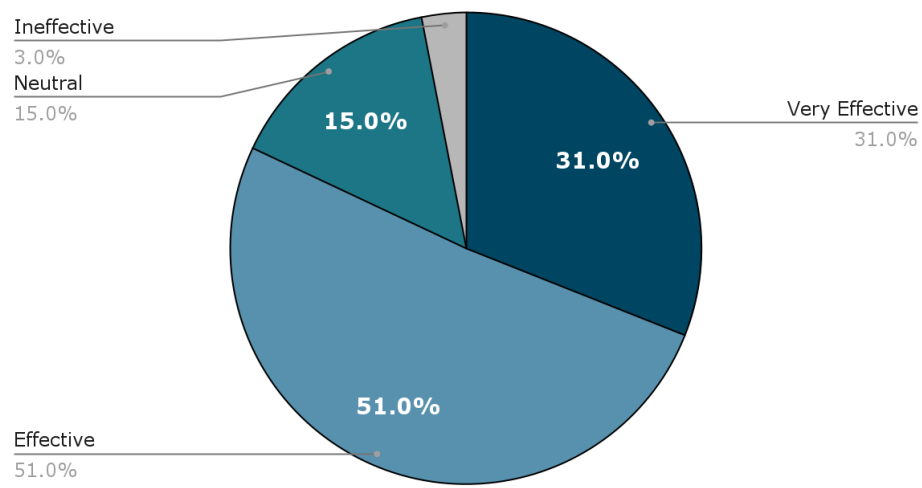

Restorative justice, restorative practices, or restorative approaches is **not** a program or a curriculum. It is a mindset and **philosophy toward school climate and relationship building** in a system. **It is a set of approaches** that allows all members of a community to:

- Actively engage and problem solve physical, psychological, social and disciplinary issues that affect their lives and the community at large; and
- Take responsibility for their actions and work with those affected to restore the community and members who were harmed as a result of those actions.

Restorative Justice is about building strong school cultures and climates. Restorative approaches focus on preventative measures and should account for 80-90% of the work in our schools.

Restorative Justice Staff

The school staff needed varies by situation and need. However, most often

- Teachers and/or Administrators
- Restorative Justice School-Based Coach
- Member of the Student Well-Being Team

Schools and families can request support from the central RJ unit, well-being social worker, or community partner agencies for consultation or facilitation as well.

Most restorative approaches, including communicating with affirmative language, listening sessions, community building circles, restorative conferencing, reintegration circles, occur at the local school level or within the community served. Since successful restorative interventions rely on trust relationships they are best facilitated within the community or school of service. Well-being team members include counselors, parent community coordinators, pupil personnel workers, social workers, school psychologists, behavior specialists, and school administrators.

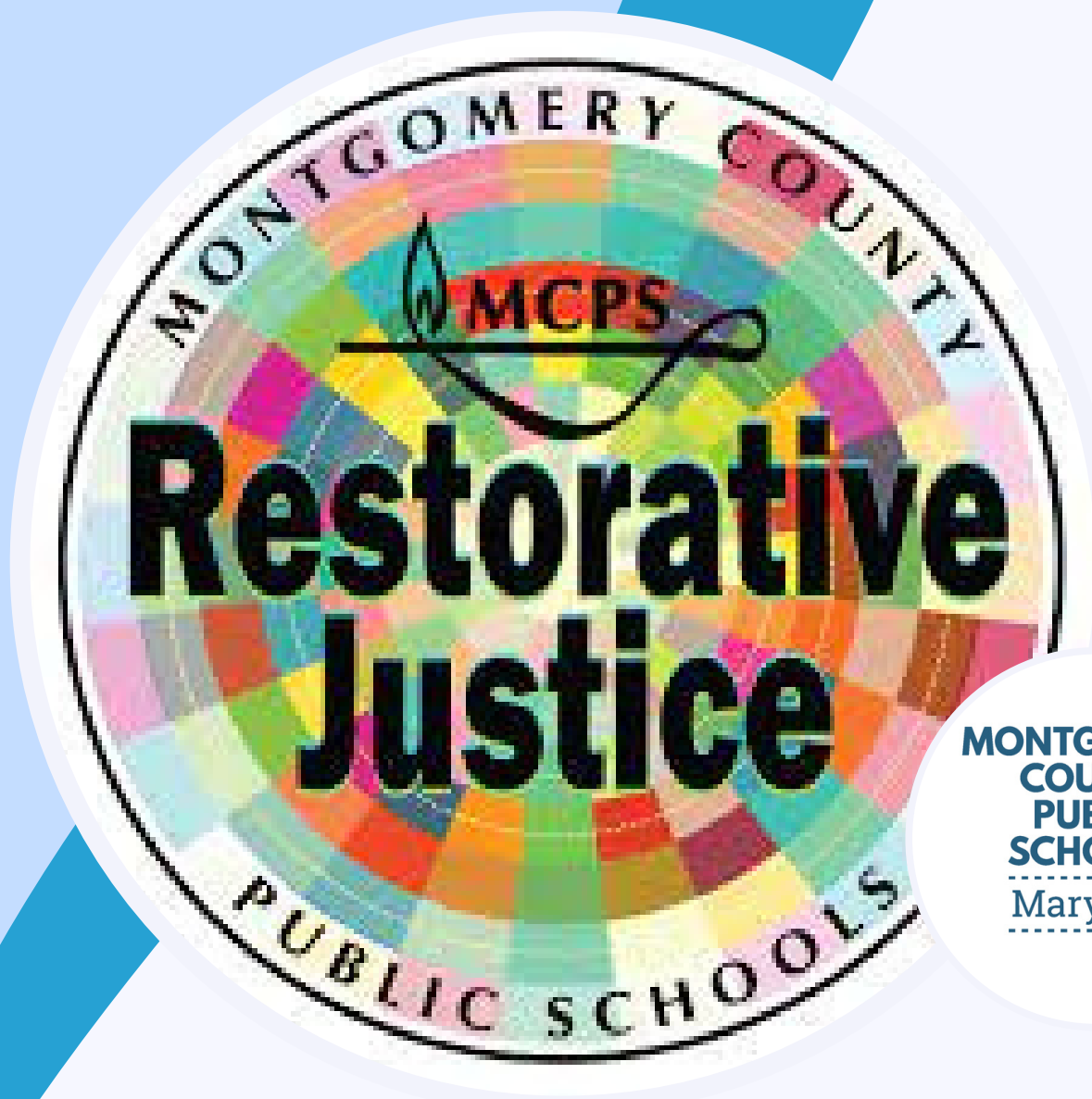
Restorative Justice Example

Two eighth grade students in a social studies class have begun to make animal noises whenever the teacher begins to speak. The behavior is disruptive and instruction has been impacted.

Action: In addition to contacting parents and referring both students to the counselor and assigned mentor teacher a restorative conversation was conducted. The parties included the **teacher**, both students, the **counselor**, and **mentor teacher**.

A parent reached out to the restorative justice unit to help to facilitate a restorative conversation with school administration. The caregiver felt that their child was not wanted due to repeated request from the school to provide updated address information. After all was settled, the caregiver felt that the school would view the child in a negative light because of the interactions and that they would not be treated fairly or as if they belonged.

Action: Restorative conference with the parent, central RJ specialist, school director, and principal.

RESTORATIVE JUSTICE IN MCPS

Restorative Justice is a mindset and philosophy toward school climate and relationship building in a system. It is a set of approaches that allows all members of a community to

- actively engage and problem solve physical, psychological, social and disciplinary issues that affect their lives and the community at large; and
- take responsibility for their actions and work with those affected to restore the community and members who were harmed as a result of those actions.

MCPS fully committed to being a Restorative Justice district at the start of the 2019 - 2020 school year. Since that time, the County has invested in Restorative Justice Coach position at all 210 schools, county-wide training on Restorative Approaches, and the addition of Restorative Justice Instructional Specialists and Mindfulness Specialists and Trainers at the district level.

This guide outlines the components of effective Restorative Justice implementation, alignment between Restorative Justice and MCPS's Strategic Plan and the Antiracist System Audit, School Performance Evaluation categories, and Aligned School Supports.

ALIGNMENT TO STRATEGIC PLAN

Every four years, the Montgomery County Board of Education (BOE) establishes a strategic plan to guide the work of MCPS. The 2022 - 2025 strategic plan identifies the priority areas of academic excellence, well-being and family engagement, and professional and operational excellence. Effective and consistent implementation of restorative approaches support all three pillars of MCPS's current strategic plans. Alignment between the strategic plan and the approaches outlined on the Restorative Justice Implementation Rubric is explained below.



- *Academic Excellence*

The Restorative Justice implementation rubric supports the academic excellence pillar of the strategic plan by requiring schools to collect and analyze the correlation between discipline and academic data. In addition, schools are charged with implementing restorative approaches that decrease exclusionary practices in order to give students more access to high-quality first instruction.

- *Well-being & Family Engagement*

The Restorative Justice implementation rubric prioritizes the establishment of restorative approaches that positively impact student well-being. In addition, the rubric identifies the need for schools to engage families and caregivers in information sharing, co-planning, and reflective practices.

- *Professional & Operational Excellence*

The Restorative Justice implementation rubric supports professional and operational excellence by requiring schools to create opportunities for staff to engage in restorative practices and training that supports the execution of effective restorative approaches.

ALIGNMENT TO ANTIRACIST SYSTEM AUDIT

In October 2020, Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) identified the need for an antiracist system audit following a series of racist incidents in Montgomery County. The racist incidents, combined with the achievement gaps for students who are Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, and/or eligible for Free and Reduced-Price Meals System (FARMS services), led MCPS to focus on addressing racism in the district to provide the highest quality of education to all of its students. The disparate effect of the COVID-19 pandemic on communities of color created an added urgency to transform educational policies, pedagogies, and practices to provide antiracist approaches that engage all students in the learning process.

Restorative Justice as a Response

The Restorative Justice Implementation Rubric outlines specific approaches that improve school culture and promote a culture of support, require the collection and analysis of behavioral and academic data, and decrease the use of exclusionary practices for students of all races and ethnicities. Schools demonstrating a need to strengthen processes and practices with approaches in these areas will receive additional support and coaching from Restorative Justice Specialists. *More information regarding alignment can be found on the Strategic Priorities Crosswalk document.*

EVALUATION OF SCHOOLS

In order to evaluate the impact of Restorative Justice work on academic and behavioral outcomes in MCPS, schools will be identified as falling into one of four categories based on an evaluation using the Restorative Justice Implementation Rubric. This initial evaluation will serve as system-wide baseline data regarding Restorative Justice implementation throughout the county. All schools will be evaluated during the second semester of the 2022 - 2023 school year by a team consisting of school administration, the school's Restorative Justice Coach, and the area Restorative Justice Specialist. Following the collection and analysis of the baseline data, annual progress goals and appropriate supports will be identified.

A description of the implementation categories is below. Further information about supports that will be provided to schools identified in the "Reactive" and "Early" categories can be found on the "Reactive Support Plan Path" and the "Early Support Plan Path" documents.

• *Reactive*



Schools in this category have yet to establish consistent and proactive restorative processes and protocols. These schools will receive intense supports from Restorative Justice area specialists following the Implementation Support Plan Path.

• *Early*



Schools in this category have some practices and protocols in place, but they are not implemented consistently across all stakeholder groups. Some practices and protocols are missing, or yet to be established. These schools will receive support from a Restorative Justice specialist following the Implementation Support Plan Path.

• *Intermediate*



Schools in this category have evidence of strong processes and protocols that engage multiple stakeholder groups. Specific areas needing attention will be addressed through targeted support from a Restorative Justice Specialist.

• *Mature*



Schools in this category have codified processes and protocols that are implemented with fidelity across stakeholder groups. Restorative Justice Specialists will work with these schools to support in the sharing of best practices within Clusters.

RESTORATIVE FRAMEWORK

In order for schools to establish true restorative justice cultures, it is imperative for all stakeholders to be well-informed about the foundation of restorative justice and how it will live in the school community. Included in this communication should be an introduction and further education on the role restorative approaches play in upholding the MCPS Code of Conduct. While the responsibility to carry our restorative practices is shared between all community members, school administrators are charged with identifying a Restorative Justice coach and appropriate resources to ensure restorative approaches are embedded in all aspects of the school's culture.

- *Common Understanding*

STANDARD 1.1: The school community (staff, students, caregivers, and community partners) have a common understanding of what restorative approaches are, why they are used, and how they impact student performance and well-being.

- *Written Protocol*

STANDARD 1.2: The school community (staff, students, caregivers, and community partners) have reviewed and understand the written protocols for behavior intervention and safety including the MCPS Student Code of Conduct and other school-based guides. These written guides are focused on accountability, learning, and restoration that will alter future behavior and repair relationships.

- *Identified Coach(es)*

STANDARD 1.3: The school has identified a Restorative Justice Coach to lead this and advance restorative efforts. The RJ Coach(es) attends summer training, monthly RJ PLC's, and school leadership meetings. Each school has regular contact with their central office RJ specialist.

- *Resources*

STANDARD 1.4: The school has allocated the resources and time to the intentional cultivation of a restorative community which fosters healthy relationships and prioritizes restoring relationships after conflict or misconduct, so students stay in school.

DATA MONITORING

The implementation of Restorative Approaches supports MCPS's Strategic Plan priorities and helps to address findings in the Antiracist System Audit. In order to ensure that the Restorative Practices being utilized are leading to the intended outcomes, the collection and analysis of quantitative and qualitative data from a variety of stakeholders engagements must be standard practice in all of our schools.

- *Stakeholder Voice*

STANDARD 2.1: The school community has established processes for collecting feedback and for co-planning with all stakeholder groups. For example stakeholder groups, advisories, or committees are established and operate within the vision of the work.

- *Review & Analysis*

STANDARD 2.2: The school has a standard process, protocol, and timeline for data review and analysis that speaks to a restorative school culture and climate. This includes suspensions, referrals, perceptual data, well-being surveys, ect.

- *Discipline & Academics*

STANDARD 2.3: The school makes specific connections between their behavior intervention and student performance data (academic eligibility, tests of achievement, EOL) . This data is articulated and shared widely with the community.

RESTORATIVE ENVIRONMENT

MCPS strives to create inclusive and supportive environments in which all stakeholders can thrive. To this end, restorative approaches are expected to be present at all levels of the organization. All stakeholder groups deserve spaces where they can voice ideas and opinions, and where they can engage in restorative approaches that work to improve the experiences of all. Our communities will continue to grow stronger as we create opportunities to gather varied perspectives, elevate and honor voice, and employ restorative approaches that promote accountability and reflection.

- *School Culture*

STANDARD 3.1: The school environment reflects a restorative culture at all levels. The student well-being team is active and effective. Restorative approaches are demonstrated in every room at each school with visuals and language such as collaborative problem-solving, affective statements/questions, empathetic listening, and respect shown to all.

- *Student Engagement*

STANDARD 3.2: All students have daily/weekly opportunities in their classrooms to participate in talking circles, community building activities, or other proactive restorative practices that promote relationship-building and community.

- *Staff Engagement*

STANDARD 3.3: Staff have regular opportunities to participate proactive restorative approaches including talking circles, community building activities, or other proactive restorative practices that promote relationship-building and community.

- *Caregiver Engagement*

STANDARD 3.4: Families are included when sharing information about restorative approaches and/or community building activities and have an opportunity to participate or provide input as appropriate.

RESTORATIVE INTERVENTIONS

While approximately 80 - 90% of Restorative Justice work is proactive in nature, Restorative Approaches are also highly impactful when utilized after a harm has been caused. Exclusionary measures, such as suspension, have long been proven ineffective as behavioral change agents. Additional Restorative Approaches are much more likely to alter future behaviors to ones that support strong and safe environments. The language we use, the processes we create, and the stakeholders we involve all work together to enable harm to be healed, accountability to be taken, and communities to thrive.

- *Language*

STANDARD 4.1: When a behavior incident arises, the school staff address it restoratively, using affective statements or questions, or asking restorative questions (What happened? What were you feeling and thinking at the time? Who has been affected by your actions? What can you do to make things better?) to promote personal reflection and accountability for conflict resolution.

- *Referral Processes*

STANDARD 4.2: The school has developed a process where students are referred to restorative conversation, restorative/peace circles and/or peer conferencing to resolve behavior incidents, conflicts, and/or other pertinent issues.

- *Staff Participation*

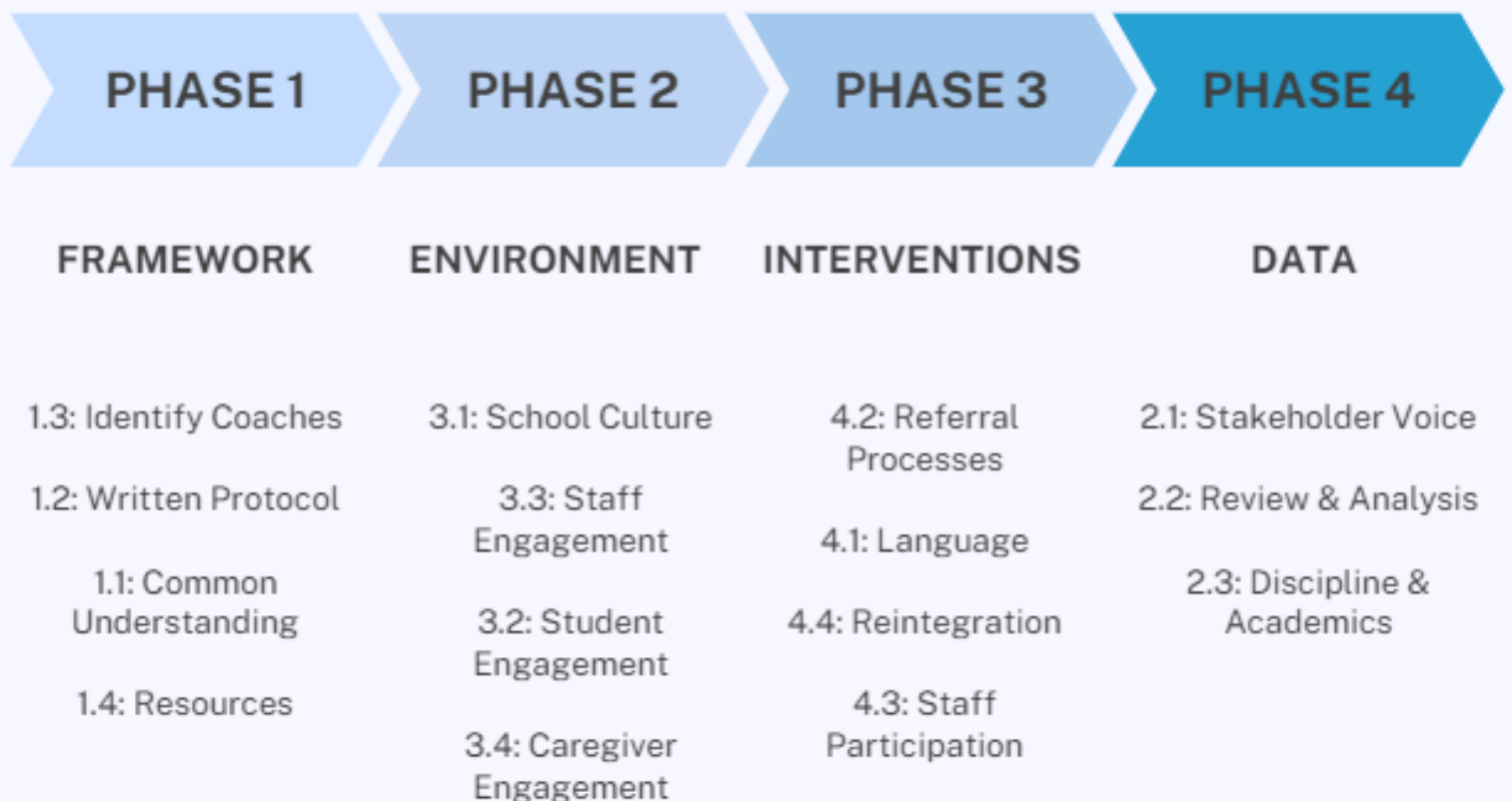
STANDARD 4.3: The school provides opportunities for staff to participate in restorative approaches to resolve conflicts or issues with students, caregivers, or other staff.

- *Reintegration*

STANDARD 4.4: When students are removed from the classroom or school due to disciplinary issues, the school has a process including a reintegration plan that ensures the student is welcomed back and restored to the community.

STRATEGIC PLANNING TIMELINE

In order to live up to our commitment of being a Restorative Justice District, MCPS recognizes the need to use data driven practices to identify implementation strengths and areas needing further supports. Given the high level of implementation variability that currently exists in the District, the need to gather baseline data to drive a three-year strategic plan is clear. A timeline for roll-out and planning over the next six months is outlined below.

- ***Data Meetings
January 2023***

Restorative Justice Specialists will be meeting with school leadership and Restorative Justice coaches to review current data, including referral, suspension, and circle data. During these meetings, RJ Specialists will share the Restorative Justice Implementation Rubric and discuss the timeframe and next steps for conducting the implementation evaluation.

- ***RJ Implementation Evaluation
February - April 2023***

In collaboration with school leadership and the Restorative Justice Coach(es), the RJ Specialist will evaluate the school using the Restorative Justice Implementation Rubric. Schools will be marked as "reactive", "early", "intermediate", or "mature" for each of the standards on the rubric. An overall implementation category will be determined through analysis of the evaluation.

- ***Goal Setting & Action Planning
May 2023***

Using the findings from the Spring 2023 Implementation evaluations as a baseline, goals and action plans will be developed for the 2024 - 2026 timeframe. Through targeted supports, continual analysis of data, and ongoing training, 100% of schools will receive an overall score of intermediate or above on the Spring 2026 Implementation Evaluation.

- ***School Support & Planning Meetings
June - August 2023***

Restorative Justice Specialists will meet with each school to collaborate on goals and support for the upcoming school year. Schools falling in the reactive and early stages during the Spring 2023 implementation evaluation will receive supports based on the School Support Plan Paths.

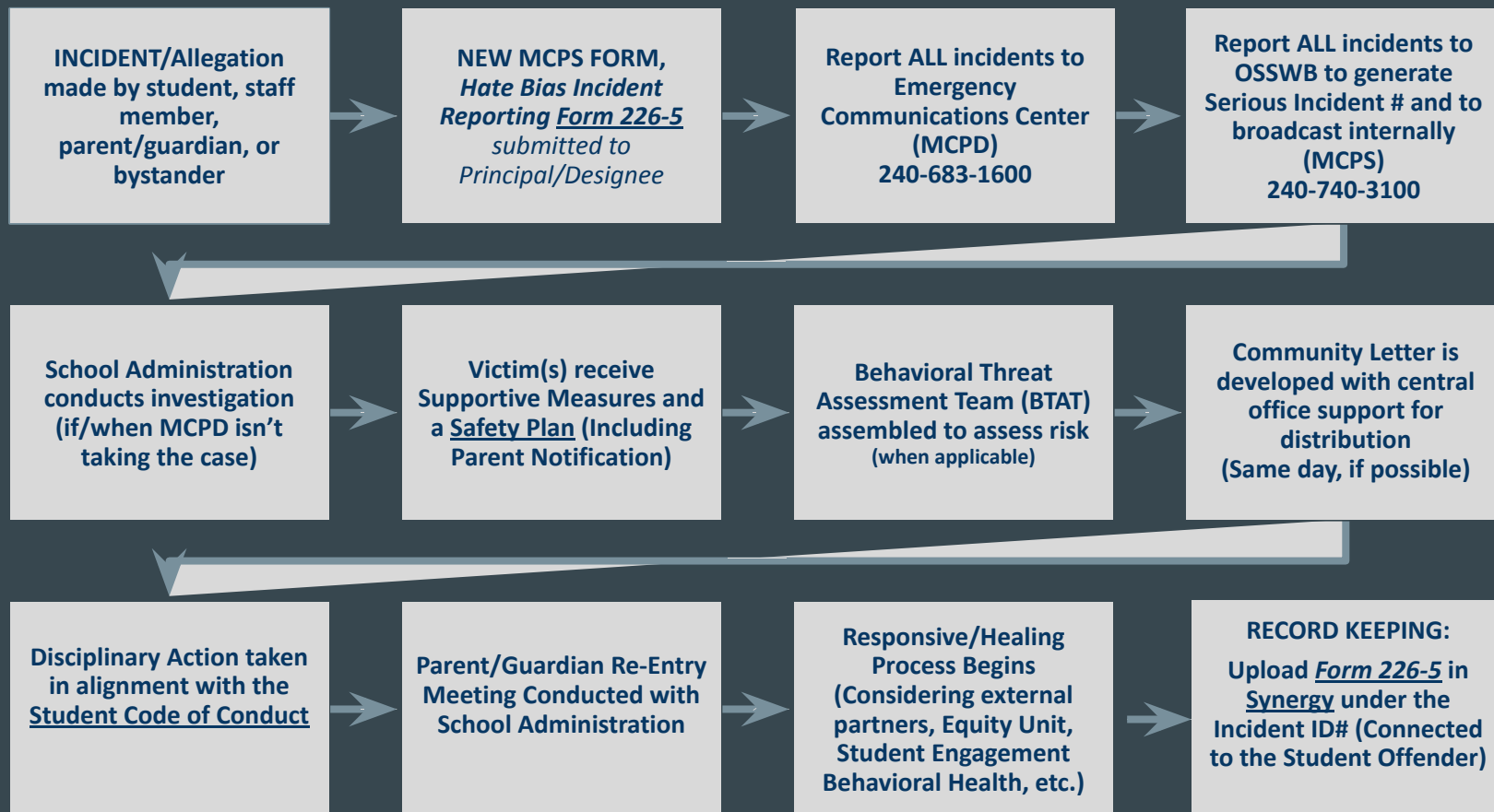

2022 SRO/SSE Training

The Safe to Learn Act of 2018 mandated development of a specialized curriculum to train School Resource Officers (SROs) and School Security Employees (SSEs). The specialized curriculum developed includes training on de-escalation, maintaining a positive school climate, constructive interactions with students, implicit bias, and disability and diversity awareness with specific attention to racial and ethnic disparities. The thirty-five-hour MPCTC-certified training program covers legislatively-required topics and others that SROs and SSEs need to study in order to carry out their duties successfully. To date, MCSS has trained over 1,100 SROs and SSEs in the State of Maryland with this curriculum.

MPCTC recertifies programs every three years, therefore in 2021 MCSS decided to take the opportunity to expand the program with new and much-needed modules and give deeper training on some existing modules. The new program encompasses seventy hours of training delivered in a hybrid learning environment. The additions and changes made will also be built into a professional development in-service class that will be made available to previously trained SROs/SSEs. The 2022 changes to SRO/SSE training are listed below.

NEW MODULES

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design | Length: 2 hours

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) is a multi-disciplinary approach to crime prevention that uses urban and architectural design and the management of built and natural environments. CPTED strategies aim to reduce victimization, deter offender decisions that precede criminal acts, and build a sense of community among inhabitants so that they can gain territorial control of areas, reduce crime, and minimize fear of crime. This module is designed to train SROs and SSEs to guide their assigned schools in creating better plans. Amongst other learning outcomes, trainees learn to recognize examples of strategies that can be employed to improve or maintain the ability of a facility or environment to prevent crime.

Crisis Intervention | Length: 3 hours

Crisis intervention is a short-term management technique designed to reduce potential permanent damage to an individual affected by a crisis. Utilizing such methods can help restore one's mental state and prevent any psychological trauma immediately following a crisis. SROs and SSEs have to be able to assess the mental health of those with whom they interact and respond appropriately. In this module the trainee learns how to identify common youth mental health issues such as depression, anxiety disorders, trauma, psychosis, and substance abuse and how to respond to panic attacks, suicidal thoughts or behaviors, non-suicidal self-injury, acute psychosis, overdose, or withdrawal. Trainees learn how to use pre-booking responses to divert individuals with mental illness and how to identify their local mental health resources, policies, and procedures.

Data Capture | Length: 1 hour

This module gives the SRO/SSE an overview of the type of data collected by MCSS and the tools used to provide the data.

Dangers of Devices | Length: 2 hours

With each new technology comes concerns about its potential impact on the well-being of our youth. In recent years, both scholars and the public have voiced concerns about the rise of digital technology, with a particular focus on smartphones and social media. This module provides an overview of digital devices, internet technology, and social media use as it relates to adolescent well-being.

Normative Adolescent Behaviors | Length: 3 hours

Most adolescents establish a level of independence and self-sufficiency that is marked by individuating from their family members and beginning the important process of transferring dependencies from parental to peer relationships. In this module the trainee develops a knowledge base of normative adolescent behavior, an understanding of the importance of strong partnerships, effective lines of communication, and the clearly delineated roles and responsibilities of school resource police officers and school security employees. The trainees establish a framework for principled conversation and decision-making to mediate and create a positive and engaging school climate while learning about alternatives to arrest when managing adolescent behavior safely and effectively within the school setting.

MARYLAND CENTER for SCHOOL SAFETY

Safe Schools Maryland Training | Length: 1 hour

This module educates the SRO/SSE all about the Safe Schools Maryland anonymous reporting system.

Understanding Intellectual or Developmental Disabilities | Length: 4 hours

MCSS expands upon mandated police officers training to make it applicable to both SROs and SSEs who have the potential to spend a great deal of time each day with persons with intellectual or developmental disabilities. In this module trainees identify the procedures that they should/may employ when encountering a student with an intellectual/developmental disability, the risk factors for wandering and elopement and strategies for searching for a missing student with an intellectual/developmental disability, and de-escalation strategies that an SRO/SSE should follow to ensure the safety and calmness of a student with an intellectual or developmental disability. Trainees must also demonstrate communication techniques required to effectively interact with a student with an intellectual/developmental disability, understand the impact sensory issues may have on a student, and describe how to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act when encountering a student with an intellectual/developmental disability.

EXPANDED MODULES

De-Escalation | Length: 4 Hours (Expanded from 2 hours)

This module dives into the difference between school discipline matters versus criminal matters and use of conflict de-escalation techniques.

Disability & Diversity Awareness | Length: 4 hours (Expanded from 1 hour)

This module defines important terms like disability, diversity, inclusiveness, and cultural fluency while exploring how individuals with disabilities may experience discrimination in various fields including education, health care, employment, economic, and justice.

Implicit Bias | Length: 4 hours (Expanded from 2 hours)

This module defines implicit bias and explains how understanding it can create a better relationship and atmosphere between students and their SRO and SSE.

Restorative Approaches in Schools – What, Why, How | Length: 8 Hours (Expanded from 2 hours)

Restorative practices promote inclusiveness, relationship-building, and problem-solving. This expanded module ensures trainees gain more than simply an overview and instead gain practical working knowledge of restorative approaches. Trainees identify at least three core values of restorative theory and three goals of using restorative approaches in schools. Trainees also identify several restorative approaches that are being used in Maryland schools and list two goals of restorative approaches that are also goals of community policing, one of which is in reference to youth programming. The trainee also recognizes three strategies for minimizing the effects of generational harm when working with students.
