

CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION

- Created -- Charter of Montgomery County. Maryland Section 509
- Purpose -- To study the Charter and report at least once to the County Council on its activities within one year after appointment. Commission reports shall be submitted not later than May 1 of every even-numbered year. The reports shall contain recommendations concerning proposed Charter amendments, if any.
- Membership -- Eleven members who shall be residents of the County, five of whom shall be appointed from a list of names submitted by the County Executive. Not more than six members shall be of the same political party.
- Meetings -- Second Wednesday of each month, 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at the Council Office Building, 100 Maryland Avenue, Rockville.
- Terms -- Four year terms to coincide with the Council term of office. No compensation.
- Staff -- Amanda Mihill, x 7-7815



Leggett Seeks Applicants for Charter Review Commission

County Executive Isiah Leggett is currently seeking applicants to fill one vacancy on the Charter Review Commission. Because no more than six members on the Commission shall be of the same political party, the vacancy is for a Republican or Independent party member.

The County Charter was amended in 1976 to provide that a Charter Review Commission shall be appointed by the County Council every four years to study the charter. The Commission researches and evaluates Charter issues raised by the County Executive, County Council, other government officials, and the public. Commission reports are submitted no later than May 1 of even-numbered year. These reports contain recommendations concerning any proposed Charter amendments.

The Commission is composed of eleven residents of the County, five of whom are appointed from a list of names submitted by the County Executive. No more than six members can be from the same political party. The chair is designated by the Council and the vice chair is designated by the County Executive. The meetings are held on the third Thursday of each month from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at the Council Office Building, 100 Maryland Avenue, Rockville.

Applicants should write by April 25 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850, or send an e-mail to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. A brief resume, with work and home telephone numbers and e-mail address should be included. Please also state political party affiliation. Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this committee are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended.

Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
