

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

- Created – Montgomery County Code Section 24A-4
- Purpose – Responsible for recommending historic sites and districts to the Planning Board for placement on the Master Plan for Historic Preservation. The Commission also acts on applications for alteration, construction or demolition of designated historic sites, and serves as a clearinghouse by reviewing proposals affecting historic preservation in the County.
- Membership – Nine members - at least one member each representing special interest, knowledge or training, in the fields of history, architecture, preservation and urban design. The remaining members are selected from applicants representing the various geographical, social, economic and cultural concerns of County residents.
- Financial Disclosure- Confidential disclosure required.
- Terms – Three-year terms - no compensation.
- Meetings – Second and Fourth Wednesdays of each month



