COUNCIL DECISION POINTS & COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Council will hold a public hearing on ZTA 19-05, lead sponsors Councilmember Hucker and Council Vice President Katz and co-sponsors Councilmember Jawando and Council President Navarro. There is no Committee recommendation.

DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

Landscape Contractor is a defined land use that is currently only allowed as a permitted use in the IM (Moderate Industrial) zone. ZTA 19-05 would allow the Landscape Contractor use in the IL (Light Industrial) and IH (Heavy Industrial) zones as a permitted use.
