DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

The County Council will hold a public hearing and consider action a resolution to 2020 Operating Budget, Montgomery County Government, Department of Finance, Economic Development Fund, \$20,00,000 for the Public Health Emergency Grant Program. The Source of Funds is General Fund Reserves.

SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- The County Council is considering an expedited bill to create a Public Health Emergency Grant Program to assist local businesses that demonstrate significant financial loss caused directly or indirectly by a public health emergency.
- This special appropriation is needed to provide funding for the Public Health Emergency Grant Program. The County will seek reimbursement from the federal and state government for any eligible costs. The Council introduced this special appropriation on March 24, 2020. The County Executive supports this special appropriation.

Background

1. Section 308 of the County Charter provides that a special appropriation is an appropriation which states that it is necessary to meet an unforeseen disaster or other emergency, or to act without delay in the public interest. Each special appropriation shall be approved by not less than six Councilmembers. The Council may approve a special appropriation at any time after public notice by news release. Each special appropriation shall specify the source of funds to finance it.
2. A new coronavirus disease, named COVID-19, appeared in China in December 2019 and spread extremely quickly. On March 11, 2020 the World Health Organization declared the disease a pandemic. The March 20, 2020 situation report from the World Health Organization stated that the number of confirmed cases worldwide has exceeded 200,000. It took over three months to reach the first 100,000 confirmed cases, and only 12 days to reach the next 100,000. As of March 23, 2020, there were 288 confirmed cases in Maryland, including 93 in Montgomery County.
3. To slow the spread of the disease, Governor Hogan declared a State of Emergency and has issued several Executive Orders with actions that include, but are not limited to, closing schools; closing senior centers and adult medical day care programs; limiting the number of people that can gather; and closing all gyms, movie theaters, and bars and restaurants (excluding carryout and delivery service).
4. The efforts to contain the spread of the disease and the disease itself could have a crippling impact on Montgomery County's local business community.
5. The County Council is considering an expedited bill to create a Public Health Emergency Grant Program to assist local businesses that demonstrate significant financial loss caused directly or indirectly by a public health emergency.

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6. A FY20 Operating Budget special appropriation is requested for the Economic Development Fund:

7. This special appropriation is needed to provide funding for the Public Health Emergency Grant Program. The County will seek reimbursement from the federal and state government for any eligible costs. The Source of Funds is General Fund Reserves.
8. On March 23, 2020 the Council received the County Executive's recommendation for a special appropriation for \$20 million to the Economic Development Fund to provide aid to County small for-profit and non-profit businesses facing hardships as a result of the COVID-19 crisis.
9. Notice of public hearing was given and a public hearing was held.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

A special appropriation to the FY20 Operating Budget of the Economic Development Fund is approved as follows:
